Coalition of Concerned Legal Michigan Voters (CCLMV) Engage Former Federal Prosecutor Brad Geyer as Legal Counsel

CCLMV has brought in former federal prosecutor Brad Geyer to represent them in their lawsuit now before the Michigan Supreme Court. The original Pro-Se filing by CCLMV is protected by the Michigan Constitution via the "legal standing" of every Michigan citizen's Right to bring this case to the Supreme Court.

Brad Geyer belongs to <u>The Former Feds Group</u>. The co-petitioners will remain in control of decisions related to the case. But Mr. Geyer will legally represent the group, appearing on behalf of the group and updating filings when necessary.

Although hundreds of Election Integrity cases have been filed across the country since 2020, this is the first case of its kind. Because the Michigan State Secretary has been working with the State Secretaries of other "swing states," the suit in Michigan will have an impact in all swing states.

The bottom line is this... without free, fair, lawful, secure and transparent elections, the good people of Michigan, and the country, have lost their voice. The efforts to subvert our national sovereignty through the dismantling of the integrity of our election system by foreign-funded Non-Government Organizations (NGO's) such as the 1630 Fund and the Open Society Foundation must be stopped. This lawsuit seeks to stop these efforts in their tracks.
