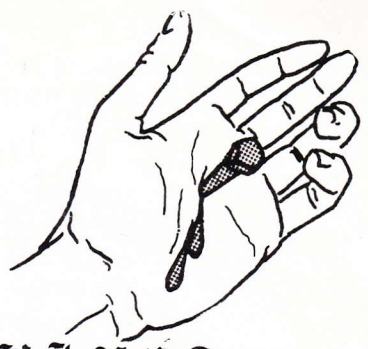

They reached the cotton shack where the Holiness people met, but they were't quite so funny as they would have bet.

They were a sight to see, this talked of band.

With their sober faces and their uplifted hands.

The preacher's name was Drake if I remember right, his sermon of brimstone to one boy was a fright. On their way back home the other boys did joke, but to him it wasn't funny holding tears trying not to choke.

Not many days later found him going back to the little cotton shack.

Wearing stiff neck collar and two button suit, was a little uncomfortable when the preacher began to shoot.

Preacher Drake said, "Let's pray with the

sinner that are here", down the aisle he went on his face a tear.

God looked down and saw his heart was right and the Holy Ghost fell on him and he shinned like a light.

Speaking in tongues, talking back to the Father, he shouted victory but the crowd didn't bother.

As the years went by he grew in knowledge and grace, he had a bright countenance and a sober face.

At the age of 21 he took himself a wife, she too was poor and had struggled up through life.

This was a fine woman so generous and good, whatsoever came along, by his side she stood.

They had eleven children, five of them died, the six that were left to raise them right, they tried.

He worked as a painter, a bookkeeper too, but his mind stayed on God in all he tried to do.

He wanted to tell the people of how Jesus came, and all that He would do if they would only trust His name.

He quit his job as a painter and bookkeeper too, and started out for Jesus saying, "I'm depending Lord on you".

He traveled several thousand miles, some by foot and some by car, sometimes by horse and wagon, but he never seems to tire.

He has been persecuted by saint and sinner too, but he says like the Master did, "They know not what they do".

He's just an ordinary fellow, would go unnoticed in a crowd, but when he tells of Jesus he stands on a cloud.

He runs and jumps and hollers and speaks of God out loud and nothing means more in his life than talking to a crowd.

Seventy summers he has seen and seventy winters to the last time I talked with him he said, "I'm almost through". Though age has touched his vocal chords and slowed down his pace, when he tells the things of God a glow comes on his face.

The last time I talked with him his age had begun to show and his eyes had a distant look to the place where he would go.

Life is like a weaver's shuttle the time seems to fly, but he will have peace everlasting when his time comes to die.

I was on my way to Minnesota with a load of dressed chickens when the wiring of my truck burned out leaving me stranded about 20 miles from town. I was stranded in weather of 50 degrees below zero for 8 hours. Everything was frozen solid. After day break a milk man found me and carried me to a telephone where I called a wrecker and they called a doctor who carried me to a hospital at Lancaster Wisconsin. The doctor called my wife Alma and told her I was about frozen to death and they were in doubt if I would make it. My wife called the children of

God at OLD SARDIS and told them of my condition. She felt sure that these saints would really hold me up in theirs prayers. In about an hour after she received the call of my condition my wife was on her way to where I was at. The doctor thought they would have to remove all of my fingers. They went as far as to say "We just like to have buried you".

After two days and nights in the hospital I was released on the condition I go just a short distance. Then we went to Hammond Indiana where my wifes niece Sis.Nell Garner lived. The afternoon we arrived there Sis. Nell told us there was meeting at BLACK OAK that night. We went to this church and Bro. Kim West's (from PLEASANT GROVE) daughter Sis.Violet Sanders was over in the Spirit of the Lord and her hands went on me. Thanks to the Lord my hands are well.

Sis.Betty Ruth McAllister brought the love of God in when she sang "The Answer Is On The Way" at WILLIAMS COVE.

"The answers on the way, this I know, Jesus said it, I believe it and it's so.

My heavenly father knows the need before we pray.

And you can rest assured the answer's on the way".

Her husband Bro.Winston was also edifying the church as he remembered how God came into his life on a island so very far from all the children of God. But he knew the Lord when the Holy Ghost came...(Amen) This was at the starting of the revival and it was on Sunday evening. Service had been good with Bro.Duke Cowan and Bro. Horace Williams both enjoying themselves as they talked about the way of God. After altar call Bro.Pope who had already rejoiced in the Lord stood up and leaned on the pulpit as he said " I'm going to stand here for a few minutes and give everyone a chance to testify for the Lord, and I'll try to pray for you". BROWN'S CHAPEL: Homecoming will be on the 1st Sunday in August with a revival to run the following week. The 1st week in August (4-11).

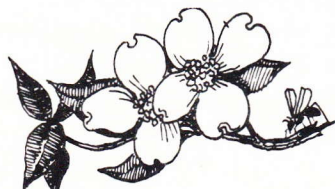
SKYLINE: Homecoming and revival will start the 1st Sunday in August (5-11).
