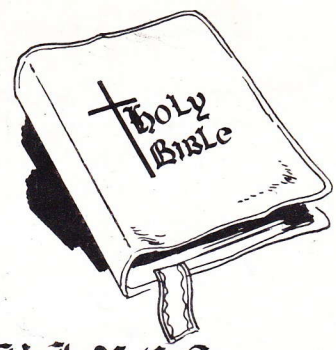

This came from a wall plaque in the home of Bro. Clifford Black, who lives in the Bryant community on the upper end of Sand Mountain.

During the Tuesday evening of the 23rd at SCOTTSBORO, Bro. Ronnie Denson recalled the time he was sitting in his car in an alley behind the HARVEY church when he noticed an incident that stuck strongly to his mind. There was a very small dog standing in the middle of this alley when a very big Cadillac with a women in sun glasses and furs came driving in. When she came to this little dog she stopped and made a commotion by blowing the car horn but the little dog just stood there and looked at her. When this failed she got out and yelled to the dog to "get out of the way". When this little feller just stayed there looking, she got back in her big car and backed out of the alley and drove off. While Bro. Ronnie watched this happening, the Lord started working with his mind on this wise; "When Satan comes against you, stand your ground (resist him) and he will flee from you".

Bro. Gerstle Peacock who lives in the North is a railroad man. Here he tells how the Lord stood by him in a bad accident.

"I had a accident in Feburary of 1972 when I was working on the railroad. I was getting on the Engine while shoving track 4 at 17<sup>th</sup> and Wentworth W. when my foot slipped (that was what I was told) and I was rolled twice between the engine and the boxcar (I was told) in a space less than 12 inches and I wear a size 46 coat. When it turned me loose I walked about five feet, with unbearable pain, when I fell to my knees and said "Lord take the pain away". As I looked up about the height of a boxcar I saw a form of a man. It had long hair and a robe to His feet and was about 12 feet tall. When I asked the Lord to take the pain away, this form settled down on me and the pain left. But when the Engineer touched me pain again shot through my body. They took me to a hospital and even though they gave me three shots the pain did not leave me this time until they prayed for me at BLACK OAK that evening. My wife Mildred asked the doctor how bad I was hurt. He didn't say how bad I was hurt only that she was a lucky women to still have me alive.

He then started to cry and she asked the nurse the same thing and got the same answer "You are lucky to have him". That was another of Gods miracles... On Sunday of the 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> a man from where I worked who came to visit me. He tried to tickle the bottom of my feet and as he did, I jumped. He said Oh! Excuse me in which my wife said "Go ahead, for I have been trying to get him to move by tickleing him also. I am ticklish on my feet but up till then I couldn't feel anything.... I was off from work 23 weeks and though I was 47 years old the doctors said I healed like a 12 year old. They said all that was broken was my left arm and it was broke in the muscle."

and myself carried her to the car. At church Bro. Wilson "Scooter" Jones and Sis. Debbie McKenzie helped us into the church with her. During the meeting Mildred testified and she was instantly healed. I believe it was the highest I've ever seen her leap and jump. I believe her hip was broke. We carried her in but she walked out. Meeting was also good with the Lord's Supper being set and the Lord blessing His children."

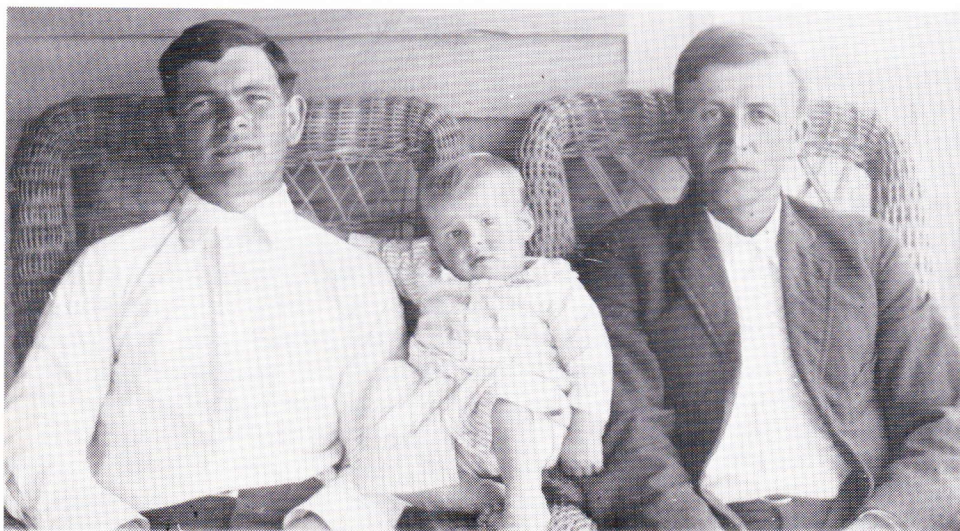

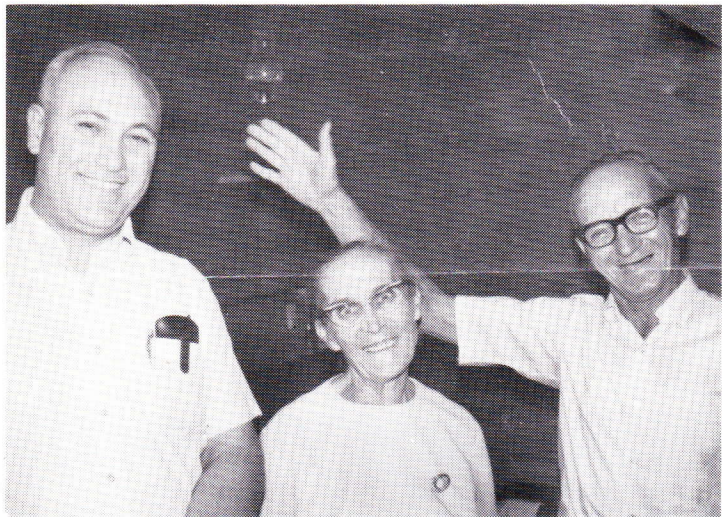
