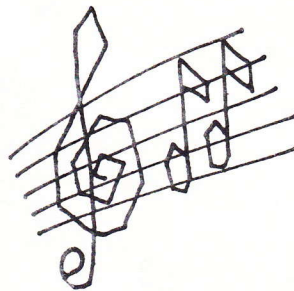

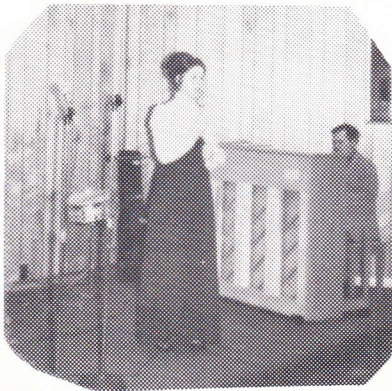

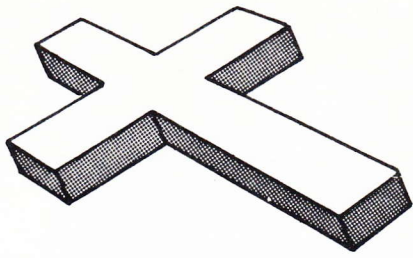

While Bro. Charlie and Sis. Gladys Brown were in the South they were blessed by God and their words of Comfort were a blessing to the church. At PLEASANT GROVE where Bro. Charlie was on the fourth Sunday morning (as we already mentioned) he used a parable:

"And he spake this parable; A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came seeking fruit thereon, and found none. And he said unto the vinedresser, Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why doth it also cumber the ground? And he answering saith unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it: and if it bear fruit thenceforth, well; but if not, thou shalt cut it down."

His talk was centered around the feeder roots of a tree receiving the right food and nourishment. "Bro. Luther always said that he believed in getting up quick to testify and sitting down quick, as the Lord was not slothful in what He did, and that was just the way Bro. Luther did, too. We loved his testimonies and we miss him. Here is one we never forgot.
