Sis. Martha Sue Helton of GADSDEN tells about her first incounter with God's people:

The husband he had went to hunt pine knots, you know, behind our house. We lived a long way in the ridges up there in Sand Valley. I thought of getting some ashes but they was to hot. Glory to God. I thought I'd kneel down here and ask the Lord if he's just heal my boy and I just wrapped up in that toe sack, Glory to God. And I asked the Lord, "Lord will you just help my little boy?" And it was just like a voice spoke to me and said "Why, you're not worthy!" Praise His name! And I said, "Lord, I know that I'm not ... " Glory to I don't know what made me say it, I didn't have no idea nobody would come but I said "...but you're able to send somebody over here that is." And I thought, I was praying when the husband come in and I had tears on my face and it just made me plum aggrevated and ashame that he caught me praying. I said, "Well, I tried to pray but it didn't do no good, I know I'm not worthy. I asked the Lord to send somebody over her that was worthy." And didn't think no more about it. Well early the next morning we seen two old people that had their shoes just hanging on their That's the truth, they had them tied on their feet, they were real poor. They had been on share-cropping. It was the year of the bolweevil. They came over there and knocked on the door and wondered what in the world are they doout as cold as it is? What'da they want? We opened the door and told them to come on in. They said, "The Lord has worried me all night to come over here, somethings wrong." Me'n the husband, just like something took our breath away. I didn't know the great power of God. Was like something fell in our home, Praise His good name. We just couldn't speak. The husband looked a little pale and he cleared his throat and he said, "Well, the boy is sick you know." ... And I reckon that hoy is the biggest one I've got now!

PINE GROVE: (Morgan County) "It is a wonderful thing to know we are serving a God that can let you know when someone in our family is going to be in trouble. This is what happened in our family a week ago and we are still praising the Lord for this. My neice has a hearing problem.

On Wednesday and Thursday night my mother dreamed three times that my neice Amy had been run over. We all began to pray that the Lord would take care of her. Well, on Friday morning at school, a bus almost hit her. Sis. Vicky Freeman was on the bus and she said that Amy didn't act like she even heard the bus. We are so thankful the Lord took care of her. Please remember her in your prayers.

Last Wednesday night we had a lot of visitors from ELKWOOD and CAVE SPRINGS. The Lord really blessed and we had a free service. (We had an elder man go to the altar for the first time. I like to encourage the older people who are praying to have faith that they can make it. IN TOUCH WITH GOD

Bro. Roy Spurgeon of OAK GROVE telling at PLEASANT GROVE (4/21/77) about one of the times the Lord healed one of his daughters:

"I lived at Birmingham and I come up here in twelve or fourteen inches of snow to get my daughter who was very ill. Bro. Cliff-ord, her fever was so high that my daddy-in-law was scared for me to carry her out, but he was good ... and I took that child and went back home. I layed her down on the couch. I was in the kitchen getting papers ready for income tax. I'd never seen anybody have convulsions. And she started and I just looked around and I seen some

thing was a happening and I went in there to see. My wife had worried with the child until she was give out and she was just a setting right at the couch where that child was. When I walked in there and just looked down, the power of the Lord just covered me up. You know, God just moved right then and healed that child. ... I don't know til today what happened. ... Bro. Gene Coffey (BEIRNES AVE), him and his wife was in the bunch that come in there. And for some reason, his wife brought the child something to eat. The child was done up a playing!!"

Bro. Willard Wooten tells of one of those "good gatherings" at BLACK OAK in days past:

"I got up there one Sunday afternoon. I guess they had a singing that Sunday afternoon at the church. About 4:30 some body came in and Bro. Lawrence and them got to shaking hands, and anyway they got to shouting and it began to catch on. Finally the house was just packed with people and it was nearly 6 o'clock and I walked in at the back They were just carrying on of the house. and having the best time. And it looked like you could just see the glory of God. I walked up and Bro. Henry met me about half way and said, "Hey Bud, you got to help me out." I said, "What's the matter?" said, "It's nearly meeting time and this has been going on for two hours. I can't get them stopped to start meeting." I walked up in the middle of that crowd and I just barely got in the center of it when somebodys' hands went on me and I hit the floor. I don't know it might have went on for another two hours, I don't know. They began to hand little babies over into that crowd and we began to anoint them with oil and there aint no telling how many people were healed that day."

Bro. Roy Martin of HILL'S CHAPEL at CAVE SPRINGS revival on Monday night edifying as he told about his first sight of Holiness. He told of when he was lost he had to move and he had two places to move to. One was on Gurley Pike or in the Bend of Paint Rock. He didn't know anybody there on the road in the Bend but he said, "I knew most of the people on Gurley It looked liked it's been good if Pike. we gone up there, but we went the other way. When we got up there, there were some people there that were kinda peculiar. Bro. Ollie, they loved one another. I didn't know anything about holiness people just what I heard. Everything I heard wasn't just right. When I got up there I began to watch them people. I could see that they had a care for one another. I could see that God was in what they was doing. I began to go around a little bit. They had meeting up there on the 3rd Sunday and sometimes to me it seem to me it would last all night. It didn't look like it bother them folks to have meeting all night. The more I looked on I began to see into it just a little bit. I thought I could but I couldn't. ... I wasn't blind or lame but He said The gospel was preached to the poor. I thought many times Bro. Titus, the man or women who gets to go to God's heaven will have to love one another. ... Not because I have to but because I've got a desire to. I believe we were founded on the rock. I believe in one place it spoke of Chirst of being that Rock. ... When they got up to sing a song, you could hear them a long ways. Glory to God! (He told of seeing the Lord heal a man) ... When she laid hands on him, he got up. He didn't get up sick but a well man! It wasn't because they were walking on the water that caused me to believe in holiness. There was an old man that got ahold of the Word of God one time going up and down the aisle. ... It seemed tike he preached hell so hot you could almost feel the heat. And I knew just as well where it was going to as he did. I was a blind man in the ways of God, but after that I could see. I obeyed the Word of God. A few days before I rec'd the Holy Ghost I didn't want anything to eat, I couldn't hardly The family would want to go somewhere and I was afraid. I was afraid something would happen to me. I was so sad for a few days. After I rec'd the Holy Ghost, I was so happy I couldn't talk. Tursday and I was working at a cotton warehouse by myself. I looked up to the top of that building and I said "Lord, I'm coming to you!" It was on Sunday about 1 o'clock on 7th day of July God gave me the Holy Ghost. I had times of joy along the way, I've had times it was kinda grivous but I'm glad I helt on to Cod. I seen the time I got down

mightly low and maybe be just going along the road or trying to pray in an old truck and just feel the good love of God. ... I was at a church one time and a man told me Comere and help us sing. I said, "I aint no good at that" He said, Well what about preaching a little for us? I said, "That takes the Lord too." I thought if I could be led by the Lord, the one who brought me out from under darkness into His marvelous light. Pray for me.

Sis. Bertie Keel was remembering old time holiness in this area years ago. She told of how they loved and helped one another. It sounded good.

He done a lot of hard work in his life time. They lived on top of Jacobs Mtn and the only way they had getting groceries and feed up the mountain was carry it on his back.


They moved from Jacobs Mtn in 1954 to Crow Mtn and lived there ever since.
