

The way of holiness

Brother **Emmitt** Drake

Te was born Emmitt Drake in the year 1878 in Madison County Alabama. He grew up and was a member of the Neals Chapel Baptist church. (This church was across from where Sis. Clara Elliott now lives) It was said of him, "He'd put on a tie and go to church all rared back and all." Another said, "That man will never rec' the Holy Ghost. He had been raised up as good as a man could have been. He stated once, "I wasn't punched out of a brush pile." He had a fine wife by the name of Nellie. ... He heard Holisness when it was first preached in Big Cove at Lige Winkles home. He said that he knew the bible better than those people but I can't get around the signs: GO YE INTO ALL THE WORLD AND PREACH THE GOSPEL TO EVERY CREATURE. HE THAT BELIEVETH AND IS BAPTISED SHALL BE SAVED; BUT HE THAT BELIEVETH NOT SHALL BE DAMNED. AND THESE SIGNS SHALL FOLLOW THEM THAT BELIEVE; IN MY NAME SHALL THEY CAST OUT DEVILS; THEY SHALL SPEAK WITH NEW TONGUES; THEY SHALL TAKE UP SERPENTS; AND IF THEY DRINK ANY DEADLY THING, IT SHALL NOT HURT THEM; THEY SHALL LAY HANDS ON THE SICK AND THEY SHALL RECOVER. He humbled himself down and one night when they went to a fish fry he stayed back and prayed until the Lord filled him with the Holy Ghost. He felt so good he said he felt like he could have walked a thousand miles. His wife rec'd the Holy Ghost also. She was a wonderful woman and Bro. Emmitt reported that she never gave him a cross word. She died just a short while later. When the death angel came after her she left here speaking in tongues. Emmitt later married Sis. Kate Walls, the daughetr of "Uncle "Bill of Piney Woods. There were 14 children all together and they often were all down praying together. Bro. Emmitt pray three times a day, every morning, before dinner and before bed at night. He was a power in the Lord in those early years. He could preach and it would come out in a singing voice. He is remembered for a sermon on the flood; "I can alomost see Noah nailing on the last plank!" This was at the Moore home on Dug Hill road. He didn't speak in tongues much but the Spirit would quiver him, and jerk him occasionally and his words carried power with a voice like a lion. And he could sing with the power of God in it. One that he liked was Open The Pearly Gates, The Resserection Morning, In The Home Of The Souland Where Shall I Be. If he was just sitting in a room and the power came on him, he would get pale and it would shake the whole house. Once some Holiness fighters dared him to come to Hobbs Island He wrote back,"If it's the Lord's will I'll be there Sunday. Bro. "Dick" McPeters was with him and he told how the holiness fighters met them with wagon

put his bible down on the ground and stood on it saying, "This is what I'm standing On!" They did them no harm. He talked from the scriptures. He knew the bible by heart. He had power with the world. Once when Bro. Floyd Kraft was arrested for not having a doctor and Bro. Emmitt was going by the Courthouse, Judge Jones said, Emmitt, when you get time, I want you to come to my office. Upon Bro. Emmitt's arrival the judge told him about the arrest of Bro. Floyd. At this, Bro. Emmitt asserted, "You can't do nothing about it. He's got scripture." Judge Jones turned Bro. Floyd loose. He was remebered in Clyde Cove about a man telling him how he whipped this man and how he whipped that man. Bro. Emmitt said, "I've seen a lot of folks I could have whipped but it wouldn't have been any honor to me." Once when in meeting he just raised his hands and everybody fell to their knees. When Sis. Clara Elliott had appendicitis, Bro. Emmitt anointed her with oil and she was imdiatly healed. Once when a cousin of his Will Drake sent a serpent down to where they were having meeting with this statement "If they'll handle it, I'll believe." When they dismissed meeting, out the door they came. The power of God knocked Bro. Emmitt clean off the porch. He reached down and handled the serpent like it was a shoe string and then stomped it's head off.

His table thanks was usually:

"Lord accept our thanks,
For these blessings,
Bless this food,
Guide and protect us,
For Christ's sake"

to come to Hobbs Island He wrote back,"If it's the Lord's will I'll be there Sunday.

Bro. "Dick" McPeters was with him and he told how the holiness fighters met them with wagon taps and other assorted weapons. Bro. Emmitt Br. Mitchell can still remeber when his mother

died and his dad was up preaching and how he would reach around his leg and hold to him white he was preaching and he could feel him tremble under the power of God. A few years later Br. Emmitt married Sis. Kate Walls of Piney Woods, one of the first to rec' the Holy Ghost in the valley.

He passed away in 1941. He had been out of the battle for some time due to failing health. He didn't have the power like he had in the early years. Troubles and heartaches had brought his mind lower but in memory he still stands tall to those who seen the glory of the Lord that was on this servant of God.

Moliness came from Chattanooga to Orme Tennessee by Bro. Tom Austin in 1907. Here Bro. Tom Perry, a railroad conducter and Bro. Sam Bates a miner rec'd the Word. By 1910 the Word had been established in Bridgeport by these two men. The same year it came to Shakerag, north of Scottsboro, where Br. Charlie Brown and his son Br. Willis Brown rec'd the Holy Chost. By 1911 the Way was opened up at Pleasant Grove and Hytop on Cumberland Mtn., by brethren from Orme and Shakerag, like Bro. Houston Sardent, Bro. Ed Jordan, Bro Charlie Brown, Bro. Bates and Br. Perry. Also in the same year Holiness came to Gunters Mtn. at Prospect through Br. Perry and Br. Bates, where Bro. Jim and Bro. Will Guffey and Bro. Jim Mills rec'd it. By early 1912 it had a foothold in the Free Home community near Grant where the Taylor boys and Bro. Andrew York accepted the Way. By the summer of 1912 the Taylors had brought it to the Piney Woods area at the home of Bill Walls.

Remembering at BIG COVE and area...

The Word of God was falling like rain on the mountain in Marshall County. It was noised abroad in every direction. One day Cebe Walls, a store keeper at Columbus City (located on the Tennessee river just off the mountain), told his cousin Bill Walls what he had heard was going on up on the mountain. As he talked about these "Holy Rollers" Bill's interest was stirred up. Shortly he was out at Free Home in one of these Holiness meetings that were held at Oliver Helton's farm where Bro. Willis Brown was living. He even was in the

floor praying before it was over. He got up and told the saints, "This is that unspeakablbe gift that I've been praying for." He then invited them to come and have meeting at his home at Piney Woods in Paint Rock Valley. "Uncle Bill", as he was known, was a very rough man and Bro. Andrew York was to say later, "The Lord used the meannest man in Madison Count to get Holiness down this valley." That night he spent the night at the Taylor home.

By the best recollections on Monday evening a wagon load of children of God from off the mountain came and had meeting at Mr. Walls' L shaped home in the Piney Woods community. Some of these were B ro. John Taylor, Bro. James Wooten, Young Richar Taylor and others.

The first night there was a good size crowd but they were on the scared side and stayed outin the road while the saints preached and sang on the porch. The following night they were a little better. They came on the inside of the fence in the yard. But the next night they were with them up on the porch and there were twenty-five or thirty in the altar praying. Bill Walls' son Joe had bees or wasps after him that day and he had pretended that he had "the power" on him as he jumped around, but this night he had a movement on him but it wasn't in pretense. He was feeling the power of the world to come. Bill Walls' daughter-inlaw, Julia (Arthur's wife) was the first to receive the Holy Ghost here. Then Bill's daughter Kate was next, then her brothers, John. and Joe came to the Lord. Bro. Joe was the one that the power was on so much when he was

seeking the Lord and it would knock him back in the floor until he told the Lord, "It's not fair!" For he wanted to stay on his knees where he could pray.... People were coming to the Lord.

From this meeting at Piney Grove the Word spread across this valley that we call Green Valley, It is surrounded by mountains: Keel and Splitrock to the north, Huntsville, Green, and Wallce to the west. Merril, Meeks and Bishop mountains to the south, with Grassy on the east. It is about fifteen miles long and about twelve miles wide. And in every corner of this valley the Word of God reached. It started slow but it went from Hobbs island on the Tennesse River to Big Cove and Dug Hill to Nebo and all along the Paint Rock river that runs on the eastern side of the valley. In the summer of 1914 Bro. Andrew York and Br. John Taylor preached at Lige Winkles (about a mile above the church) house and Al Hunters home (about two a half miles above the present BIG COVE church). Dick MacPeters's wife Maude was the first to come to the Lord here. She rec'd the Holy Ghost at Claude Byrd's home. Clara Bunch was next. She said, "I knew there was something to it because of the change in Maude. Sis. Maude rec'd the Lord on Sunday evening. Sis. Clara on Wenesday evening. so after this Fannie Elliott came to the Lord. Sis. Clara married her son later. Br. Emmitt

and Sis. Kate Byrd. Then Sis. Kate's brother Br. "Dick" R. H. MacPeteres, Sis. Maude's husband, who became a preacher. The Montgomery's were coming to the Lord. Walter Montgomery had told the Holiness people they could have meeting at their home. His wife, Myrtle, could not stand the thought of them people coming in to her home. She remembered a vacant house on the hill and suggested to Walter, why didn't they fix it up for those people, they'd have Walter didn't find out until lamore room. tar why she was so anxious to have meeting up there. Myrtle told her daughter Bessie about them people coming and "That preacher York is coming to our house!" Bessie told her she wasn't a bit afraid of him even though they had heard how they threw powders on you that made you jerk and etc. Bessie was first to ree'd the Holy Ghost then Br. Walter and finally her mother rec'd the Lord while praying

in the mountains. Before they came to the Lord one of their twins took real sick. Some of the people came in to pray for them. The baby was in one room and they prayed in another room. The Lord got in the prayer and Sis. Julia Walls went across the hall on her knees and up the step into the room and her hands went on the baby and it was healed. The Lord was blessing and the Word was falling and the signs were following the believers. The sick were being healed. Sis. Clara had appendicitis. Br. Emmitt anointed her with oil while praying over her and she was imediatly healed. This was after they had given her up to die. They were casting out devils. Br. Andrew York was asked by a John Dunn from the New Hope area to pray for him. Br. Andrew went on his knees and raised his hands. He put his hands on Mr. Dunn and the devil was cast out. Mr. Dunn keeled over like a dead man and stayed that way for two hours and fifteen minutes. When this was reported to the law they arrested Br. Andrew and put him in Jail. They took up serpents. Someone turned a serpent out at Jim McKellett's. Br. John Taylor went out and said, "You better be careful!" Br. Arthur Walls with bible in hand said, "Br. John, the bible says THEY SHALL

TAKE UP SERPENTS." They took it up. Once when some of the world brought a rattlesnake in where Br. Emmitt and Br. Willis Brown They then turned it were having meeting. loose. They wanted to see if it would hurt any of them people. Sis. "Red" Dorn had a baby in one arm as she reached down and took up the rattlesnake in the other. When they were having meeting at Neals Chapel Methodist church, two McKellevy boys brought a copperhead serpent in a tied sack and hung it in a tree. During the service a blacksnake came and wrapped around the sack. Br. Arthur Walls, "A good humble child of God," took and handled both of these snakes after service. He had his a hold of them by their mouths and they just hung there life-less. Br. Claude Byrd took up serpent and it died in his hands. Old Br. Wilcox said this about taking up serpents: "Some people wait for the power before taking up a serpent. Bless God, it's been on me ever since I got the Holy Ghost!"

John and Lou Boulden Medley, Ed Elliott, Ernest and Tilly Winkler and others were coming to the Lord. Sis. Flossie Castle had moved to Bugs Chapel, a community south of Owens Crossroads. She was from Bridgeport where she had heard the Word of God and had rec'd the Holy Ghost. Her husband John never came to the Lord but he respected the Holiness people. At Bridgeport she had opened her house to Holiness and she had fed and had them sleep at her home much. All the old ones like Br. Tom Austin (He is the one who brought Holiness to Orme), Bro. Tom Perry, Br. Sam Bates, and the Guffeys and others. When she moved to Bugs Cahpel meeting were held at her home often here too. Here is a letter that was written by Sis. Flossie in the winter of 1914. It is the oldest Holiness writing from this part of the country that we have ever seen or read.

I beseech you therefore brethern by the mercies of God that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God which is your reasonable service. Rom 12:1. That does not mean for us to live one day for Jesus and the next day for the devil. It means all the time following His footsteps all the way, bearing the cross through trials temptations and afflictions.

Almost any one can follow Jesus as long as they are in good health, have plenty to eat, and when there is no fighting to do, but when the enemy is in view, that is the time for us to stand steadfast and unmoveable. Though troubled on every side yet not distressed, we are perplexed but not in dispair, persecuted but not forsaken, Cast down but not destroyed, always bearing in our body the dying of our Lord Jesus that the life

also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body.

Sometimes it seems temptations will almost overwhelm us, but we hear that sweet voice, "Follow me." Oh how sweet to feel the nearness of Jesus, to know His grace is sufficient, that He will never leave nor forsake.

This is a meek and lowly way. If Jesus was here on earth would he wear jewelry or costly raiment, or chew tobacco or dip snuff? Oh brothers, sisters, let's lift the banner high, lift up Jesus to a dying world.

We must lead pure clean lives before the world if we expect men and women to be drawn to Him.

How high are you lifting Him up? How many sinners have been constrainted to fall in love with Jesus because of your example or influence?


Once at Sis. Flossie's house some of the sons of Belieal put up a sign: NOTICE NO HOLINESS MEETING AT THE CASTLE HOUSE. But it didn't work, they just kept on having services and the Lord kept on blessing. One night they had seven preachers at this house. They were: Bro. Will and Br. Jim Guffey, Br. Jim Mills, Br. Andrew York, Br. Enmitt Drake, Br. Dick MacPeters and Br. Eunice Byrd. Once when Br. Tom Hill was here at this house they came with guns to throw him out, but nothing ever came of it. The more they persecuted these Christians the more the Lord blessed them and the larger the number of them grew. Preacher Roy (the Montgomerys used to belong to his church before they rec'd the Holy Ghost.) the Church of Christ precher slipped up behind Br. Wilcox and grabbed him by the shirt and poured culbolic acid down his shirt. People that were present started begging the

old man to hurry to the doctor but he just walk out saying, "Glo-o-r-r-y-y to-o God!!! It didn't even burn." This Roy is the same one who called the Holiness people in for a debate then refused to let them speak. They just got up without a word and one by one they left him here. Edgar Terry took it upon himself to mock them and he started shaking himself like the power was on him and he couldn't stop. He told people after that this was sent on him by 'the Lord for his mocking them Holiness people. Others would go down the road mocking and making out like they were Throwing things at the speaking in tongues. children of God and rocking their homes was common. But these saints just kept on keep-They had meeting all ing on for the Lord. night, sometimes. Sis. Clara Elliott remembers, "We used to get home a lot of times in the broad day light." Once atBr. Walter Montgomery's house when Sye Stapler, Minnie Sims and Henry Stapler rec'd the Holy Chost "A bunch of us walked across the fields about a mile to Sis. Pinkertons and she started breakfast for it was broad day light. And it was said by more than one about how they used to sing in the Spirit. (I have never heard this done but they say it is beautful to hear and out of this world. A point that is very interesting is that everyone that we have interviewed concerning singing in the Spirit say they can't remember a word that was sung but some remember the tune.) Sis. Clara sang in the Spirit once to the tune, I'm Walking In The Light.

Br. Monroe Taylor Br. Jim Guffey and Br. Charlie Brown were in a meeting here in the Cove with a number of angery preachers. As Br. Rob preached and was pouring it out, one of them said, "Hey, you say your sanctified both soul body?" Br. Rob relied, "Yes sir!" "You don't mean to tell these people you're sanctified both soul and body?" Br. Rob said, Yes sir! My little finger is sanctified!" That preacher said, "Well if that's all it is, I don't want to hear any more." Bro. Rob said, "You're excused!' and just continued on.

Put Faith on the Line

Bro. Horace Williams was at TIFTONIA (5/4/78) and talking on giving God the Glory. He also stressed on Faith without works is dead. "Did you know, brethern, that faith without works is dead. Listen! Hears what the Word of God says. What does it profit my brethern though a man say he has faith and has not works, can faith save him? I might see my brother really in need and me with a few dollars in my pocket and I say "I sure hope that brother gets along O K." Now brethern, that aint works. Now if we do what we should, we'll divide what we got with him. If a brother or sister be naked and destitute of daily food, and one of you say unto him, "Depart in peace, be ye warm and filled." notwithstanding ye give them not those things which are needful to the body; what doth it profit? If you got just a little bit of money and the Lord tell you to take it over to a brother or sister in need, ... Oh, I've never been no happier in my life then when the Lord had me give the last cent I had. Even faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. Praise the Lord! We're just gonna have to have some works. . Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: Shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works. ... Thou believest (has faith) that there is one God; thous doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble. ... But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is DEAD. Now, this is what the Lord seem to put on my mind. Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar. ... When Abraham and that little boy, he carried him up there and the boy stood by and watched his daddy build the altar. I believe with all my heart that he meant to take his son's life. Yes, I got two boys and I really love my children, they are so close to me. Suppose in the morning God would tell me to go to up yonder make and altar and take that youngest boy and offer him up for a sacrifice. Oh, when I prayed, I'd be on my knees asking God to spare the boy. But Abraham loved God so much he was willing to take his son's How loving and true. life. As he laid his boy up on the altar he no doubt was thinking how much he enjoyed him in these years. ... she could depend on. I might be bent up a little bit. I might get knocked and beat and glanced over a little bit, but Glory to God, if I'll stay humble in my soul, it don't matter. This is a spiritual warfare and it's operated and controled by the Spirit of God, and all in the world God needs is for me to stay outa the way and let Him run it. I just need to stay in good enough shape that if He needs me He can just reach and get me. Alright now, were talking about building on the right foundation.
