This happened near Woodville Alabama. So Br. Tom was raised in the Way of Faith. He rec'd the Holy Ghost in 1936 at BEIRNE AVE. the year after he married Ruby Kilgore. After this he moved to the

He and everywhere to church, but was most often bound where the saints and church felt cast down and forgotten. Hodges Moore who knew him well all his life, said, "He was a genuine, old time, child of God!" Also, "I never saw him miss it." He was loved by the young and old and will live in many hearts until they are united again in that good land to come.

Br. Tom Buckner was a humble man, a man full of love, a great man, a man God could deal with. His teachings never strayed from, and his daily life was lived in accordance with the teachings of Christ.

Many times, as God began to deal with him he would reach for a song book, walk out on the floor, and start a song. By the time the song was finished, those in his presence felt as though they had heard a great sermon and their hearts were uplifted because of it.

Br. Tom often admonished the young children of God to get their feet established in the Word of God.

One of his last sermons preached here at our church (90 miles from his home), shortly before his death, began with Proverbs 16: 2 All the ways of a man are clean in his own eyes; but the Lord weighteth the spirits. Commit thy works unto the Lord, and thy thoughts shall be established. The Lord hath made all things for himself: Yea, even the wicked for the day of evil: Every one that is proud in the heart is an abomination to the Lord: Though hand join in hand, he shall not be unpunished. By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: And by the fear of the Lord men depart from evil. When a man's ways please the Lord, he maketh even his enimies to be at peace with him. ...

During one of his last visits here a sister mentioned to Br. Tom that she had been worried about his failing health. His answer to her was. "Don't worry about me, now. Just get your feet planted and hold on and you'll make it." Could anyone have better advice.

As long as we live, Br. Tom's teachings will live on in our hearts.

Une day when I came back from riding around, I heard Brenda my sister-in-law call me to come down to her trailer. When I got down there, Brenda opened the door and there was Sis. Carol (Hereford), down on her knees. She told me they were fixing to pray, "Do you want to pray with us?" I didn't know it then but she had been home praying and the Lord told her to come ask me to pray. She was still somewhat a stranger to me, but I told her, "Yea, I'll pray." That's the first time I done like that. I got on my knees. I started feeling funny because I had pants on. I asked them, "Can I put a dress on?" So I changed. Then we began to pray. At first I listened to them, because they prayed out loud. I wasn't taught that way. I was used to the preacher praying out loud and the rest of us praying to oursleves. There was one brother who got up and was talking about the walls of Jerico and how they came tumbling down. He got to walking around Sis. Shirley, then another and then another. He then said, I don't want to get out of my place, but I want to raise you up in the name of the Lord." She said that during this time, "I believe the Lord preformed an operation." We do too.

Dr. Dewey Barrier at NILA on the 1st Sun. in January talking on the Works of the flesh:

"UNCLEANLINESS: Morally impure. Morally,... what you study about, how you do. Would you people believe that the morals of the American people, that in the last twenty-five years that the morals of the American people have really lowered. Twenty-five to forty years ago I never heard of a divorce in my community. People just didn't do that. When a man and woman married they just live together. I'm hesitant to mention this, saints, but I want to tell you why I believe some of this has come about. I believe by the means of television, that so much of this is put on before the face and before the crowd that after awhile we just get used to it. The heros among our young people are the ones that are doing these things on television. I believe the time will come, saints of God, when, under the fear of God, when Holiness people will want to get shed of television. Because what you set and look at. Say, "Well it's got a knob on it!" But most of the timeafter they've done done and said what they was gonna do and say, it's to late to turn the knob then saints. I believe if you set there every day or every night and listen at this man curse, and you watch this man drink wiskey and beer and youwatch him make love to another man's wife, then after awhile when your neighbor starts doing that it's not going to look so bad to you because you're used to it. and your children's used to it. It's dangerous. And it's hard to talk about saints. If we're going to get to the place called Glory world, we're gonna have to be careful. ... I want to ask you something saints, the program you watch, would it be alright if my wife and I came in and set down with you and watch it? Or would there be something on it that would be embarassing. If it was I'd swap programs. I believe that it has done more to lower the morals of the American nation than any one thing. The Beatles came into this country a few years ago and our young men of our nation went wild over them. Started letting their hair grow out. That was the first start of these people having long hair. Do you know if the Bealtes had come over here and people didn't have access by the way of a television set chances are our young people would still have short hair. Think aboutit saints.

(If Br. Dewey was wrong, Br. Will Guffey and Br. Willis Brown and about all the old men of God who have gone on were wrong beause we heard them speak the same way except they talked with the bark on, not as easy as Br. Dewey did this day.) the scripture speaks expressedly of Jesus Christ sitting on the right hand of the Father in His Glory:

... sat down on the right hand of God.

Who being the bright ness of His glory, and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the Word of His power, when He had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the majesty on high.

IT IS REAL

Is the Holy Ghost real? That was my question for years, maybe I should say, the question I ran away from for years.

I had been raised in Holiness all my life. Mother and Daddy (Sis.Florene and Br. Julious Bailey) always carried us to church and raised us to be good. When I was fourteen or fifteen I felt I needed something in my life. I couldn't stand the thought of dying and going to hell to burn forever. I went to the altar to pray for the Holy Ghost. People told me I really got close. All I could think of while I was praying was what would my husband-to-be think. What would he think of a Holiness girl. So, I never went back to the altar.

We were married and after about a year, I joined the same church my husband and his family attended. It wasn't long after that I went up to be saved and was baptised. The only thing was, I never felt anything. I couldn't even give a testimony at my baptising. I was faithful attending church and Sunday school. I kept wanting to feel something. I wanted to really know I had salvation. I would pray and study the bible; but always turn away the little thought, "You need the Holy Ghost." I kept thinking, "... at church they tell me I'm alright, so I must be." This went on ten years. After my Mothers death, I realized how fast a person can leave this world. I knew I wasn't ready to go.

The Lord began calling me. I just didn't know if the Holy Ghost was real. I knew Holness people were good and had something that kept them. I just knelt on my knees and asked the Lord, "If the Holy Ghost is real, show me." Oh! I felt the Lord's power! I knew right then what it was. I had never felt that way before. I had asked sincerly and the Lord answered. I began praying but kept thinking what would my husband and friends say if I rec'd the Holy Ghost. I had to tell my husband I had to have the Holy Ghost.

He told many times (and it was his life) of how the people would say of Holiness, "It's no trouble to tell they are right, just look how they love one another." One night at the school house where they were having meetings, he promised the Lord, if you'll forgive me of my sins, I'll be baptized, if it's in the dead hours of mid-night. The Lord forgave him there, and he had Br. Andrew baptise him in Bean Creek near Brown's Mills about 11 o'clock that night. Then in September of 1923, he knelt down by his bedside in his little two room home, as humble as he'd ever been in his life. The Lord gave Him the Holy Ghostand he shouted into the little cook room, a very happy person. One thing marked his sojurn with us. That was, he was a MAN OF BLESSED ARE THE PEACEMAKERS FOR PEACE. THEY SHALL BE CALLED THE CHILDREN OF GOD.

"On Sunday night at BLACK OAK I got up to testify. When I sat down, I felt worse then I did before I got up. The next morning I went to work and my job was to bring in bales of cotton from the outside. That morning I went to take the top bales off from a stack fifteen or twenty feet high and the top bale fell and hit me in the back. I thought I was dying and the first thing I thought of was that I testified the night before. The next thought was, "Lord, I'm ready to go" and the most peaceful feeling came over me. I couldn't move but all the pain was gone and I was feeling the Lord. I don't know how long I laid there but finally someone came and when they saw me they thought I was dead. A big crowd gathered and stood looking at me. I guess I looked bad for they told me later that blood was running out my eyes, nose and mouth and ears. Finally an ambulance came and they got me into it and started to the hospital. By this time I had gotten to where I could talk and the drivers kept asking me if I was alright. They just didn't know how alright I was. When we got to the hospital there were several doctors and nurses gathered around me an they wanted to give me some shots. I said that I didn't need them and they were really amazed they said aren't you hurting? I said, "No." They took me up to X-Ray and then put me in a room and told me that the vertebras in the lower part of my back were crushed. They said that it was like putting an egg in your hands and crushing it, that they were in splinters. They said I would never walk again or if I did that I would have to have support and canes. I was unable to move my legs. When they left I was trying to pray and I reached down and slid my legs off the bed. They were right I couldn't walk or even get back into bed. They had to come and put me back. The nurse really bawled me out. She said "don't you know that you could snap your spine trying that." I didn't say anything, but I kept trying and got in a couple of days to where I could stand and by holding on to things shuffle my feet and walk a little. I really wanted to get home where I could get the children of God to pray for me. I asked the Dr. on Friday when I could go home. He just laughed and said "I'll let you go when you can bend over and touch your toes." I began to try to pray for faith to do that and on Saturday I called Bro. Billy Williams and asked him to ask the children of God to pray for me that I could touch my toes. That night about the time I thought they would be praying I started down the hall to a bathroom with the intentions of trying. Every foot of the way satan tried to discourage me. He told me that if I did, I'd snap my spine and kill myself or never be able to walk. But I was determined to try. I got in the bathroom and leaned up against the door and prayed. I said "Lord those children of God are praying for me and I've got confidence in them, I'm going to try if it kills me." When I did I tried and didn't have a bit of trouble. I was so full it was just bubbling over as I nearly ran back down the hall to where my wife and mother were. I said, "Look here!" I bent down and touch my toes again. The next day, Sunday, the doctor didn't come in but on Monday when he walked in, I got out of bed and bent down and touched my I told him I was ready to go home. He didm't say anything but to get back into bed and he toes. examined me. After he left the nurse came and told me he had released me to go home. The next day when I left my room the head nurse had a chart in her hand and she would look at the chart and then up at me and she asked, "Are you Mr. Parker?" I told her I was. "... blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy. The children that come up when they get about twelve years old, they think they don't have to do what mother and daddy says. They think they can go out on their own, and many are doing it. But children, as long as you got a mommy and daddy, the Word of God commands you to obey them. I do not care if you're forty-five years old, the Word of God says to obey them. ... these young boys and girls are getting to the place where they are heady, highminded. We are living in a wicked and adulterous generation. I tell you parents, it's getting to the time, if you've been to leinent on them, you'd just better bring them back to the line. If it takes you using a hickory on them, the bible will back you up, and the Lord will stand by you. There's people who will say, "You'd better not whip them, you'll get in trouble. I have one over here, sixteen, and one over here twenty-four years old, and if they still need a whipping, I've still got the authority. I wouldn't do it unless it was necessary and it aint been to long since it was necessary. If we don't obey the Word of God, when we stand before Him, we'll be just as guilty as the child. Mother will ask their children to do something and the mother ends up doing it herself. You mothers aint got no business doing that. I know it's real easy for the child to put up an excuse. But I don't care how much homework you got to do. If momma tells you to do the dishes, you leave the homework alone and go wash the dishes. Don't speak back to them. If you do, you've disobeyed the Word of God. When they say, "Do it!", you do it and don't answer again. If you don't, you'll be one of these, disobedient to parents. When I was a child at home, my daddy never told me the third time to anything. Usually it was one time. Once when I was young , my motther slapped me for something and I throwed me a little fit. While I was doing it, I didn't know my daddy walked around the corner of the house. He didn't even make his appearance out there, he just turned and went to a peach tree, cut him off a limb about this long. And before I knew what was happening, he was up there were I was at. And when he got through with me, I knew better then to throw a fit again. Now there are children today who are getting by with it. Every where in the Word of God that you read about a child being corrected, the father is the one required to do it. But you mothers can help out a whole lot. ... despisers, without natural affections, turcebreakers. Now if that child is allowed to go like that, this is where he'll end up. truce breakers. Go out here and make a truce with somebody and it won't mean a bit more then nothing. He don't care to break it. Why?

Because he never was made to do that back at and he still don't know to do home They are children of God now that was it. not taught at home, wasn't strict on them, now they don't know how to do on their own. Because they wern't taught at home. It was the parents fault. Listen to what it says. Truce breakers, false accusers. If you don't want your child when he is grown to be false accusers, people, don't you do it and don't you allow them to do it while they are growing up. Incintent, fierce, dispisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasure more then lovers of God. Now, where all this starts is when the child about, ...18 months old. If you want your child to come up like God is pleased with, when it needs correcting, you'll have to correct it. It might be hard sometimes but it's necessary. There's people will tell you if you whip that child and leave marks on it, they'll report you . They call it child abuse. Now, Soloman had more wisdom of Cod then any man. He told how to bring a child up. He said if you beat it, it shall not die. Talked like if you left it without chastisement, it would bring it's mother to shame. That's what's happening today, they've been let go allowing them to wear long hair. You might say, My son don't have the Holy Ghost, so I'm going to let him wear it." Well, It says, bring them up in the nuture and admonition of the Lord. If you'll do that, God will stand by you. I'm presuaded that God will give you power over your child.
