And Sarah was an hundred and seven and twenty years old. And she died. Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the fie eld of Machpelah before Mamre.



I've thought often about how the Lord told Abraham to take his only son and offer him up. He said take your son up there and offer him as a sacrifice. Abraham loaded up his mule, got everything ready took Isaac with him. Got there and the boy said, 'Here's the wood,

where's the sacrifice." His daddy told him, "Son God will provide." He took that knife to take the boys life, and God thru His angel stayed his hand, ... and looked around and there was a ram... But he went to the last He drawed back to take that child's life. And God knew He's take it, and that is as soon as God moved. ... He had to go all the way. Now listen, The just shall live by faith. I'm not up here fighting doctors. I want you to know that I belive they do a good job. I'm up here fighting for your and my soul. That when the Lord comes back, we'll have faith in Him.

Listen, These all died in faith. Are we going to die in faith. "Ah, if you trust the Lord, you aint gonna die." Bless your heart, everybody... the one living a hundred and fifty thru everything you can. I know it been rough years ago died. Are they around now? Any of the apostles around now? They all die. Some thing took them out of this life. "You mean they killed the children of God?" Absolutly! They killed them. Something else I belive, I belive if me and Br. Elton stays with the Word of God, you know what our chances are of getting out now without being punished? You are going to have to live to the place where God can use you in these afflictions and be persecuted. Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the plasures of sin for a season; Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt ... "Oh, I tell you, if it wasn't for what people would say about me, I belive I could trust God. If they just wouldn't look down on me."... Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches... for he had respect unto the

And what more shall I say for time would fail me to tell of Gideon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, and of the prophets; who thru faith subdued kingdoms, wrought rightousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouth of lions, Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakeness were made strong, waxed valient in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens. Women rec'd the dead raised to life again. Woulnd't you loved to have lived back then? The Lord sure was taking care of his people, wasn't He? Oh, He was. He was taken care of them.



Did you know...?

Halloween is the name given to the eve before All Saints Day. All Saints Day is, of course, a Roman Catholic religious observance. From the dark ages, the eve of that day was looked upon as a time for the worship of Satan and demons by those who, rejecting Christianity, sought to create a satanic opposite for every Christian observance. Halloween, then, is a satanic holiday. It is as satanic as the so-called black mass, or as the practice of witchcraft.

That the satanic origins of Halloween continue to dominate its observance today is very plain. The standard symbols of the observance of Halloween are witches, goblins, ghosts, skeletons and the like. The apparently harmless lighted pumpkin face or "Jack-O-Lantern" is an ancient symbol of a damned soul. The name is derived from that of an evil fellow named Jack who, denied entrance to both heaven and hell, was doomed to wander in the darkness, his way lit by the glow of a coal from the fires of hell held in a hollowed gourd. What a dreadful toy for the children or decoration for the home! When Christians permit their children to celebrate the Halloween holiday, they are permitting them to engage in the remnants of a satanic holiday. Halloween is, in reality, degenerated Satan worship.

Scripture, in the 18th chapter of the book of Deuteronomy, very explicitly forbids Christians to have anything to do with witchcraft, spiritism or the demonic. In verse 10 of that chapter we read: "There shall not be found among you anyone that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire (this has reference to the worship of the pagan god Moloch through child sacrifice), or that useth divination (divining rods and "witching" sticks), or an observer of times (astrology), or an enchanter, or a witch (medium), or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. For all that do these things are an abomination unto the Lord..." The term witch has reference to mediums who think they can bring up demons impersonating the dead. A "familiar spirit" is a demon who seems to be at the disposal of a medium but who, in fact, deceives and controls the medium. "Necromancy" has to do with those who in one form or another seek to find information for the present by consulting with the dead. It is obvious that the elements of the Halloween observance with its emphasis upon goblins and demons, witches and skeletons, ghosts and apparitions rising from cemeteries, constitute a dabbling with the very things which Scripture forbids to God's people, and an open invitation to demonic activity.
