BR. RANDALL STONE: "I worked in law enforcement. I really like that. But the Lord worked this out for me. Something was missing. I loved to fish. I'd go fishing with my friends and I come in. I couldn't even enjoy fishing. I'd say, "Somethings missing." She would say, "You know what it is?" I knew what it was. She put up with me for ten years without the Holy Ghost. I was in Louisiana. I went to New Mexico. Got set up. Met some nice people. Got me a good job. Got to making some real good money on an oil drilling rig. It wasn't too long, I got these fingers smashed. AND YE HAVE RESPECT TO HIM THAT WEARETH GAY CLOTHING, .. ARE YE NOT PARTIAL IN YOURSELVES, AND ARE BECOME JUDGE OF EVIL THOUGHTS.

I CHARGE THEE BEFORE GOD AND THE LORD JESUS CHRIST, AND THE ELECT ANGELS, THAT THOU OBSERVE THESE THINGS WITHOUT PREFERRING ONE BEFORE ANOTHER, DOING NOTHING BY PARTIALITY.

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

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Unity

A Christian does not have the "unity of the Spirit" with someone who is not a Christian! "Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty" (II Corinthians 6:14-18).

So Paul is speaking of those who are in the body of Christ; they have this unity of the Spirit.

Then why all the separations?

Paul tells us, in Ephesians 4, that the Lord gave some in the body various gifts—apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers—"For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love" (verses 12-16).

You will notice, from these verses, that the Lord gave the ministry the responsibility of bringing the saints into the "unity of the faith"; yet, the fact of the matter is, the ministry are the ones, as a rule, who divide and separate the saints!

I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase. So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase. Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labor. For we are laborers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building. According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon. For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ."

When men seek to make a name for themselves, when they seek to build a "religious empire," when they seek a following, they will divide and separate the people.

God is the one we are to love with all our heart. Christ is the one who gave Himself to redeem us, He is the "head of the body, the church," and in all things He is to have "the preeminence" (see Colossians 1:18).

The ministry are to do as John of old, point souls to the "Lamb of God that taketh away the sins of the world," for they are ambassadors of the heavenly kingdom.

Christ is the head of the church, the King of the kingdom, the government is on His shoulders, and He sends His ministers out to represent Himself, and not themselves. Spell of wealth seen as sometimes enslaving

Generated by the drive for profits and possessions, the nation's financial-commercial magnitude is deemed the gauge of its strength and stability, and also the pull of an insistent appetite.

Any disturbance of that monetary focal point shatters the nerves of social structure.

Yet at the financial hub of ancient Jerusalem, Jesus unleashed his most vehement and strenuous attack. Swinging a braided rope whip, he stormed the outer marketing court of the Temple, overturning currency-exchange tables, scattering livestock, merchants and customers.

They had turned a "house of prayer" into a "den of robbers," he blazed. "Take these things away!" The ancient historian Josephus and the Jewish Talmud tell of the profiteering, corruption and greed prevailing at that time in the Temple's operations.

It was the country's civic-financial religious capital, controlled by a Sadducean aristocracy in collaboration with Rome's military rule, employing more than 120,000, a lucrative industry involving the monied power elite.

In Jesus' onslaught on that financial power center, the armed guards apparently held back, fearing popular support for him there in that half-mile-square trading arena, rimmed by massive marble colonnades.

The foray led soon to his crucifixion by Rome for treason. His action had struck at the controlling core of that country and of many since. It also struck at what Jesus treated as a pervasively endangering human malaise — the all-consuming shackles of mammon. unparalleled federal deficit, banks and farms going under, plants closing, the stock market lurching wildly.

A culture "devoted to consumerism, materialism and the pursuit of

"You cannot serve God and mammon," he said, explaining that to concentrate mainly on it shrivels higher human responsibilities and capacilities, finally obliterating them.

The word "mammon" isn't just a neutral term designating means of exchange, but stems from an Aramaic root meaning "to trust in," thus indicating key allegiance, a binding supremacy, cutting into an end, not just a means.

The result is what Roman Catholic priest-theologian John C. Haughey calls "mammon illness," a kind of numbness_that. "happens slowly without one being aware of what is happening," turning money into an end, not just a means.

This "mammonolatry" is more common now than in Jesus time, Haughey writes in his book, "The Holy Use of Money," with modern society overwhelmingly preoccupied with consumption and production, distorting beneficial objectives of it.

"For the love of money is the root of all evil," writes the missionaryapostle Paul. "It is through this craving that some have wandered away from faith."

The affliction, along with huge arms purchases and other imbalances, has overloaded and seared the economy of the United States, richest of nations, yet gripped by an money as its major ends" blocks "the possibility of authentic community," says a 1987 analysis by the United Church of Christ, "Faith and the Economic Life."

It is among six U.S. church evaluations, recommending modified premises in U.S. economic life.

Although this country is at a peak in prosperity and consumption of commodities, variously needed, just wanted or bought unneeded by inducements of advertising, about 33 million of its citizens remain impoverished, 8 million homeless, up to 3 million homeless roaming the streets and soup kitchens.

Around the globe, nearly a billion people, a fifth of all of them, are poverty-stricken on an earth with resources and capabilities of nourishing all, yet about a half-billion suffer chronic hunger.

The gap between "the well-to-do and the poor is widening daily at an all alarming rate," says Episcopal bishops in their 1987 statement on "Economic Justice and the Christian Conscience."

They say economic imbalances threaten disaster both for "the prpsoperous and the poor" without some deliverance from the idolatry of false priorities — overweaning individualism, human avarice and social irresponsibility."

"In our society today," they ad "the drive for wealth and pow simply for their own sakes h become so pervasive that we ha created — 'money culture'," endangering passion growi "cheek-by-jowl with extrem poverty."

As philosopher John Alexand puts it in his book, "Your Money Your Life": "We're trying to acqu possessions when we should be try to disentangle ourselves from them

Jesus discerned that deep-root deforming passion in various ind duals he encountered, advising wa to break free of it.


He told them to keep that Passover in remembrance that God had brought them out with a strong hand. Delivered them from bondage. And, everytime they eat that, to remember that was what it was for.


I told him the doctor would be in and tell him he was going to be alright and in the morning he would tell him he could go home the next day. And he did.

AND TO BE CALLED, RABBI, RABBI(a title of honor; master). 
