Dress Rehearsal

What is Dress Rehearsal?

Dress rehearsal gives dancers the chance to experience the recital exactly as it will happen – in full costume, complete hair and makeup, and on stage. This practice helps them feel comfortable and prepared. It also allows parents to walk through the process of getting ready, timing arrivals, and making sure everything runs smoothly for performance day.

Competition Team

Competition Numbers will not be run at rehearsal. This may affect timing during rehearsal - this is okay! We will adjust for this timing.

Additional Information

1. Dancers should arrive to the venue with hair and makeup completed. Female students should arrive in their nudies with a robe or clothing over top.
2. Costumes may not be worn to and from the venue.
3. Staff will come get your student when it is time for them to go to the stage.
4. Dress rehearsals are closed, meaning that only staff may be in the auditorium.
5. When your dancer comes back from their number, please change them into their next costume and have them wait quietly for staff to get them for their next number.

FAQ's

 - a. To protect the privacy of the dancers that will be changing for routines, we do not want anyone to take photos in the dressing room. You may go into the hallway with your dancer to take a photo, and then allow them to return to the dressing area to wait their turn to go to the stage.
