WE'VE BEEN ON THE TELLY!

Our Kitchen Team were very excited to have a BBC Film Crew filming us! Two journalists and a cameraman came along to find out what Food For Families was about. They were snapping away at us doing the cooking, peeling potatoes, stirring the stew, and putting the family Bonus Bags together. We had to do several 'takes', all while trying to cook 150 meals!









THE BONUS BAGS

When we started planning what Food For Families would be doing, we thought that we would only be cooking a meal. But then Morrison's offered to give us a 'food collection' day, which meant we were receiving a lot of tinned food and sundry items. A lot of this couldn't be used by us in the cooking, so we decided to give each of the families a 'Bonus Bag' with a few additional items in, to help stretch their food budget a little bit. It was a bit serendipitous, and families could get different items each week as we never knew what we would be given. But then, Jez Cartwright came along, and asked if he could sponsor the bags, to ensure that families could have these bags every week. It has made a huge difference to the families we support.

150 MEALS

When we started cooking in February 2023, we really weren't sure how many families we should cater for. It was a huge leap in the dark. We knew that prices were rising – food, fuel, heating, all going up and we knew that for our local families this would be a very difficult time for them. It was strange because we wanted the numbers to increase, but obviously that meant that there were more families finding it hard to survive with the increased living costs. In just 7 weeks, we have increased the number of meals we are cooking from 12 to 150.
