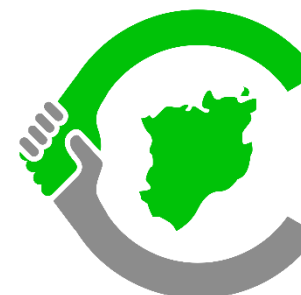

What Is Caithness Rural Transport?

We offer a door to door transport service with an adapted vehicle for people with transport problems regardless of age.

How Do I Use It?

Just ring our office on 01955 605588 between 8.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. Monday - Friday.

Tell us the following information

- The time you want to travel
- The pick up address and destination
- The time of your return journey
- How many people want to travel

Who Can Use It?

Anyone living in Caithness who has no transport or reasonable access to any public transport regardless of age. Disabled and elderly throughout the county.

When Can I Use It?

All vehicles operate 7 days a week between 9am and 10pm. Evening and weekend service is dependant on volunteer drivers.

Can I Bring An Escort?

Yes. They will pay a basic fare of £2.00 but you must tell the office at the time of booking the journey

How Much Does It Cost?

There is a charge per person per journey depending on the length of the journey.

1 mile = £4.00	2 miles = £5.00	3 miles = £5.50
4 miles = £6.00	5 miles = £6.00	6 miles = £6.50
7 miles = £6.50	8 miles = £7.00	9 miles = £7.00
10 miles = £7.00	11 miles = £7.00	20 miles = £10.00

There is a membership fee of £17.50 paid yearly on 1st July, which may be done by completing and returning the application form overleaf.

Will I Get Assistance to board the vehicle?

Yes. The driver will be there to assist you with the steps or wheelchair access.

Is It Just For Special Journeys?

No! You can use it for almost any purpose. Go shopping, visit friends and relatives, social functions, medical appointments, go to the pictures. Remember we operate over the festive period!
