### **What Is Caithness Rural Transport ?**

We offer a door to door transport service with an adapted vehicle for people with transport problems regardless of age.

### **How Do I Use It ?**

Just ring our office on 01955 605588 between 8.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. Monday - Friday.

Tell us the following information

- The time you want to travel
- The pick up address and destination
- The time of your return journey
- How many people want to travel

### **Who Can Use It ?**

Anyone living in Caithness who has no transport or reasonable access to any public transport regardless of age. Disabled and elderly throughout the county.

### **When Can I Use It ?**

All vehicles operate 7 days a week between 9am and 10pm. Evening and weekend service is dependant on volunteer drivers.

### **Can I Bring An Escort ?**

**Yes.** They will pay a basic fare of £2.00 but you must tell the office at the time of booking the journey

### **How Much Does It Cost ?**

There is a charge per person per journey depending on the length of the journey.

1 mile = £3.50	2 miles = £4.50	3 miles = £5.00
4 miles = £5.50	5 miles = £5.50	6 miles = £6.00
7 miles = £6.00	8 miles = £6.50	9 miles = £6.50
10 miles = £6.50	11 miles = £6.50	20 miles = £9.50

There is a membership fee of £15 paid yearly on 1<sup>st</sup> July, which may be done by completing and returning the application form overleaf.

### **Will I Get Assistance to board the vehicle ?**

**Yes.** The driver will be there to assist you with the steps or wheelchair access.

### **Is It Just For Special Journeys ?**

**No!** You can use it for almost any purpose. Go shopping, visit friends and relatives, social functions, medical appointments, go to the pictures. Remember we operate over the festive period!
