

The Path to the Cross and Beyond

Resurrection Day 2022 Worksheet Exercise #1

The doctrine of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ is central to the New Testament and foundational for the theology of the Church. The resurrection of Christ is the basis of all New Testament truth. If the resurrection did not occur, we have no such thing as absolute Biblical truth.

Our main points:

- Jesus died with a purpose towards God – to redeem us from our sins.
- His body was buried - a sacrifice well pleasing to God.
- His dead body arose - overcoming death and giving the Gospel its overwhelming power.

1 Corinthians 15:13-19 If the resurrection had not occurred, what is the result?

1 Corinthians 15:1-4 Define the Gospel.

Point #1: Jesus died with a purpose towards God – a sacrifice to redeem us from our sins.

John 19:30 What was “finished” here?

Point #2: His body was buried - a sacrifice well pleasing to God.

John 19:41 How did God the Father view the value of the sacrifice His Son made? (Also see **Ephesians 5:2; Matthew 26:28; Romans 4:25; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Galatians 1:4; Galatians 3:13; Ephesians 1:7; Hebrews 10:11-12; 1 Peter 2:24; 1 Peter 3:18; 1 John 2:2; Revelation 1:5**)

Point #3: His dead body arose - overcoming death and giving the Gospel its overwhelming power.
