Disney Premier Access = Paid Lighting Lane (\$10-\$13 per person per ride)

- Pay per person in your group and pick a time to come back and skip the line. You have no cap on the number of rides you can pay for, you just need to wait 60 mins between buying each ride (Or if you've already bought and used a pass within that 60 mins, you can get your next quicker)
- Attractions: Most rides in the park including Zootopia and Pirates

Standby Pass = Free Virtual queue for some busy locations

- Usually turned on during peak hours at popular restaurants, or if there is a new merch drop at a specific store
- Also used for some attractions with no standby queue, or a full standby queue
