WHEREAS, the Town has a contract with Vector by which they maintain a camera identification system for the Town that facilitates the billing of aircraft utilizing the East Hampton Airport; and

WHEREAS, the addition of an additional aircraft identification pod will assist the Town in identifying aircraft using the two most eastern taxiways; and

WHEREAS, the costs for the system hardware and installation will be \$24,200.00 but the Town has a credit of \$20,000.00, reducing the sum due from the Town to \$4,200.00 for installation, plus future annual operations, processing, monitoring and maintenance (OPM&M) the first year of installation of \$3,000.00, increasing annually thereafter by 3%; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to have the additional aircraft identification pod installed as set forth in Vector's proposal dated March 7, 2019; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby accepts the March 7, 2019 proposal of Vector for the installation of an additional aircraft identification pod at a total cost of \$24,200.00, with a credit to the Town of \$20,000.00 being applied,, plus OPM&M of \$3,000.00 for a net cost of \$7,200.00 to the Town the first year, such costs to be paid from budget account SX5610-54500; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Vector consistent with their proposal for such installation; and be it further

RESOLVED, that future OPM&M costs of \$3,000.00 per annum shall be increased annually after the first year by 3% annually and be paid with the Town's other OPM&M fees.
