WHEREAS, Hyannis Air Service, Inc. has numerous clients that frequently use flight services at East Hampton Airport; and

WHEREAS, Hyannis Air Service, Inc. has requested a license agreement so that it may maintain a counter space at the Airport Terminal for the purposes of directing their customers to the appropriate arrival and departure area for flight services; and

WHEREAS, the Town of East Hampton is legally obligated to accommodate aeronautical providers wherever possible. This requirement comes from Grant Assurance 22, which requires sponsors to make its aeronautical facilities (like terminal space) available to the public and its tenants on terms that are reasonable and without unjust discrimination; and now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor is hereby authorized and directed to execute a license agreement, of a license agreement with Hyannis Air Service, Inc., the term is for one calendar year, renewable upon mutual consent of both parties, for a licensing fee of \$50,000 per year and in a form to be approved by the Office of the Town Attorney, for use of space in the East Hampton Airport Terminal for servicing their customers utilizing flight services.
