WHEREAS, on September 23, 2019, the Town of East Hampton's Airport Manager issued a notice of suspension to Analar related to two incidents that he believed resulted in unsafe and disorderly conditions at the East Hampton Airport; and

WHEREAS, members of the Town Board and the Airport Manager have met with representatives of Analar to discuss both of the incidents giving rise to the suspension and Analar has provided details of the events to explain its actions and provided certain assurances to provide for better communications with the Airport Manager to avoid conflicts in the future; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board has determined to lift the balance of the suspension and to maintain an observation period for the balance of the original suspension period; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a stipulation with Analar reflecting the terms of this resolution, upon approval of the Town Attorney and Aviation Counsel.
