The mission of the TWA Museum is "to preserve and celebrate the extraordinary legacy of Trans World Airlines (TWA), educate visitors about its pioneering spirit and contributions to aviation history, and to inspire future generations." From the birth of airmail to the inception of passenger air travel, to the post-WWII era of global route expansion, TWA led the way for 75 years. The great influence that Trans World Airlines has had on MKC, and the City of Kansas City, Missouri, is one that history can never ignore.

The TWA Museum's goal is to ensure a permanent, expanding and professionally exhibited collection of artifacts that bring the story of TWA to life here in Kansas City, where it all began. The Museum is dedicated to the preservation of the legacy of Trans World Airlines' leadership in the world of commercial aviation.

Our first Trans World Airlines Experience will take place on March 23, 2024 and we will host an event about once each month thereafter. For larger groups, we welcome you to host your own private Trans World Airlines Experience, which is priced the same as our open-seating events.

Location

Your Trans World Airlines Experience takes place at The TWA Museum, 10 Richards Road, Kansas City, Missouri 64116. Our museum is located inside the Signature Flight Services building. Our Cabin Trainer was one of the last remaining TWA treasures in St. Louis, located at the Trans States Airlines Headquarters. That building formerly served as the TWA Charles A. Lindbergh Flight Training Center, and was also the former Ozark Airlines corporate headquarters. Museum volunteer Larry Dingman alerted the museum as to the existence of the trainer, and after a series of communications with the City of St. Louis, and St. Louis Lambert International Airport, our Museum formally acquired the Cabin Trainer on June 11, 2018.

Several volunteers helped disassemble and remove the trainer, and other related items, from the building and transport those pieces back to our museum. The entire project - disassemble and reassemble - took almost 2 years to complete. Greg Tyler, former TWA Avionics Technician from Indianapolis, and Gary Mayden, who at the time served in St. Louis as a TWA/American Maintenance Crew Chief, served as "point men" to schedule the crews assisting with the project.

The Cabin Trainer served as a training "tool" for flight attendants. After their initial training, flight attendants were trained annually for an emergency review to demonstrate their competency on door operation and portable



emergency equipment. This Cabin Trainer was located on an elevated level of the building, which allowed flight attendants to perform actual slide evacuations. The trainer was built upon a massive hydraulic platform, which allowed the trainer to actually move to replicate turbulence. Smoke machines also were also used to fill the cabin with smoke.







Trans World Airlines Seating Chart 707-727


