I also wanted to share with you what wonderful things can happen when you rescue a shelter dog. This is about Buster, a cockapoo, who was found starving and abandoned in a field. His new "Mom", Jeanne Howard, provided the love and care he needed to blossom into a wonder dog. He became a certified service animal and also passed the tests to become a regular "visitor and moral booster" at University Hospitals. He was also a greeter at Pet Pals events. Because of the care and patience of his owner, he touched many lives with joy and laughter.

Buster was 13 when he went to the Rainbow Bridge but he left behind a legacy of hope, kindness and the power of love. He's an example of how much potential the animals in shelters have and the many rewards for those who adopt them.



PET ADVICE

Be sure to check your pets' collar regularly. Ensure it is snug but not too tight to cause pain or too loose which could cause your pet to lose the collar and possibly escape with no identification.

Keep all rubber bands and string away from your pets. If swallowed, they can become dangerous and may lead to surgery for removal.

Keep electrical cords out of reach. Dogs and cats could get shocked if they chew on the cords or could cause a lamp to get knocked over. Try hiding the cord behind furniture or use a cord cover for the safety of your family pet.

Be extremely cautious when choosing plants to bring inside your home. Some plants can be deadly to your pets.

Keep all cigarettes away from animals. They can get nicotine poisoning if they chew on the cigarette butts.

Keep all chocolate away from your dogs. Chocolate is toxic to dogs. If you suspect your dog has eaten chocolate, take them to your veterinarian immediately.
