Susan Alexander Nicholson

News reached us that **Susan Alexander Nicholson** died February 8, 2018. Born April 1944, Susan arrived at MHC as a freshman from Scarsdale High School, NY. *The Scarsdale Inquirer*, July 1961, listed Susan as one of 32 graduates from a class of 318, to receive highest honors. At MHC, she majored in Political Science. Classmate **Margaret** "**Meg" Jandl** relates that they met in Latin class freshman year and that she "remained friends with her (and her mother!) the rest of her life."



Susan graduated from the U. of Maryland with a J.D. in 1973 and was admitted to the bar that same year. Her solo practice law office was in Hagerstown, Maryland. She focused on Estate Planning, Probate and Trusts and Estate cases.

Meg confirms that she was married twice, with no kids. Her second husband, Somerville Nicholson, died in 2010. His obituary published in the *Princeton Alumni Weekly* indicated they were married 39 years and that they "lived in a circa-1795 house in Fairplay, Md., on a small farm with stream, barn, pasture, and the essentials for their equine rescue work."
