Naomi graduated with a math major and then received an M.A.T. from Johns Hopkins in 1966. She returned to her high school alma mater to teach math and her career at Jamaica High School, in Jamaica, Queens, New York City spanned 30 years. Naomi is remembered as a gifted teacher by her students, many of whom kept in touch long after graduation. Her passing came after an 18 year-long battle with Parkinson's Disease. Naomi was widowed twice (she's pictured here with her late husband Stanley Stolar) and is survived by her sister Susan Schindler, MHC 1963 and also a math major, her seven stepchildren and a loving contingent of grandchildren.
