

# Spirit Championships Competition Scoop

## Registration/Check-in:

- Registration check-in will begin 1 hour prior to first team of the days warm up time. The registration area will be in the front lobby.
- A representative from each team must check-in to receive team wristbands.
- 2 Coaches per team are FREE for the event. Additional coaches' bands may be purchased at registration.
- Please bring the following items to registration:
  - Rosters
  - Copy of Waivers

## Warm up

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing a coach's wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than 5 minutes prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- For athlete changing areas, please utilize nearby bathrooms before entering warmups.
- All teams will compete on a 42' deep x 54' wide carpeted flat (non-spring) cheer floor.
- Each team will have an allotted time to practice on multiple stations (check in/stretch, stunt/tumble mat and a full mat)
- From practice area you will move to "on deck" area to prepare for your routine. If you miss your practice time, Spirit Championships cannot guarantee another opportunity to practice in the designated area.
- **We recommend bringing a water bottle for each athlete with their name on it to warm-ups.**

## Scoring

- Deduction sheets can be picked up approximately 10 minutes after performance.
- Any requests for review must be submitted within 15 minutes of deduction sheet being picked up. Coaches may not approach the judges stand. A form must be submitted at

the registration table and the coach will be called to speak with the head judge after the review is completed.

- Scoresheets may be picked up at the registration table immediately following the conclusion of awards.

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## Spectator Information:

- Doors to the facility will be open 30 minutes before first team compete time.
- CASH ONLY will be accepted
- The cost of admission will be:
  - Adults \$20
  - Students (4-17) \$15
  - Children under 4 are Free

## Parking Information:

- Parking prices will be provided the week of the event. Parking fees are set by the venue and are typically \$5-\$10. NO Portion of parking revenue is shared with Spirit Championships.

## Schedule information

- Tentative performance times will be emailed to program directors the week of the event. The performance order will be updated as changes are made.
- Spirit Championships always attempts to ensure teams from the same program with crossovers do not have overlapping practice and performance times. Please report any crossovers at the time of registration.
- No Division changes will be accepted after final schedule is released. (Late changes may result in a \$50 fee)
- QR codes to scan for performance order will be available on-site day of event.

## Performance Viewing

- Spectators will be able to watch performances from Priority Viewing Area which will be located directly behind the judges stand.
- Only approach the Priority viewing for your team's performance and promptly exit the area when the team finishes.
- Please follow all onsite instructions to help make the viewing experience positive for everyone.

## Event Merchandise

- Event Merchandise will be available for purchase onsite throughout the event.
