#### A Little Bit of History by David Pope

President Truman's last car - a '72 Newport. 400 powered, few power options. A plain old Newport for a plain old President. Not a New Yorker, an Imperial LeBaron, a Plymouth Fury, or a Dodge Polara. A nice car, but not ostentatious.

"5745" honors V-E Day, May 7th 1945.

He passed shortly after he bought this car, and his wife Bess was chauffeured in it until she passed in 1982. The number 5745 was permanently retired by the State of Missouri with this license plate.

This historically significant C-body, maybe the most historically significant C-body, has about 47,000 miles on it, I believe.
