### Plot

*In burial practices, a plot refers to a specific area of land within a cemetery where an individual or family has purchased the right to bury their deceased loved ones. Each plot is sold as one casket interment right or three urn interment rights per plot.*

Member of the Old Presbyterian Meeting House	\$3500.00
Member of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), but not a member of OPMH	\$5000.00
All other denominations (including Baptist, Catholic, Anglican, and others)	\$6000.00

### Niche

*In burial practices, a niche typically refers to a small, recessed compartment or space within a columbarium or similar structure where cremated remains are placed. Each niche is sold as two urn inurnment rights per niche.*

Member of the Old Presbyterian Meeting House	\$3500.00
Member of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), but not OPMH	\$4500.00
All other denominations (including Baptist, Catholic, Anglican, and others)	\$5500.00

### Administrative Fee

#### Columbarium

Inurnment fee (per individual)	\$1250.00
--------------------------------	-----------

*This process involves placing the urn containing cremated remains into a designated space within the columbarium.*

#### In-Ground

Interment of an urn (per individual)	\$1500.00
Interment of casket (per individual)	\$1850.00

*This process involves the burying of a casket as well as the burial of cremated remains in the ground.*

Dedicated Memorial Bench	\$2000.00
