Redlegs Reunion Scheduled 17-21 June 2024

Our last "All Redlegs" Reunion was in 2019 at Fort Lewis (JBLM) and the Seattle, Washington area. Fort Lewis was the home of the 4th Infantry Division before their deployment to South Vietnam in 1966. One afternoon, we visited with a HIMARS unit while touring Fort Lewis (now JBLM). This time, we will join in a week of excitement and fellowship while we gather at Fort Carson, Colorado, and help celebrate IVY Week with the 4th DIVARTY and the entire 4th Infantry Division.

We have arranged for at least 15 rooms at the Candlewood Suites (Building 7306)I on Fort Carson. The room rate, including breakfast, will be \$169 per night (plus tax). Each room in the hotel has a fully equipped kitchen with a full-size refrigerator. Laundry facilities are also available. We will also arrange nearby accommodations for Redlegs who don't want to stay on post or when we exceed the room quota. While they will release our allotted rooms that haven't been reserved by 1 May, we may get additional rooms at this TDY price if rooms are still available. If you are interested in attending this year's Redlegs Reunion, you are encouraged to submit your initial reservations as soon as possible. Because the hotel is on Fort Carson, we will be required by the hotel to submit a list of attendees before you can make your actual reservation with the hotel.

Plans are in the works for visiting the Air Force Academy, the Air and Space Museum, and the Gog Railway up Pikes Peak. There is also the Cheyenne Mountain Zoo, the Golden Bee at the Broadmoor, the Garden of the Gods, and many more activities to enjoy during our reunion. Branson Veterans' Week 9-12 November 2024

We will again host the Branson Veterans' Week. Hospitality Room for the 4th Infantry (IVY) Division National Association at the Hotel Grand Victoria. The Veterans Day Parade will be on Monday, 11 November 2024. Arrangements have been made with the Hotel Grand Victoria at the same rate as 2023 (\$111.00 plus tax), including breakfast. That rate will be available for nights beginning on 6 November and departures on 12 November 2024. You are encouraged to make your reservation early to get a room on the same floor as our hospitality room.
