PCGC 2026 Membership Renewal Reminder, Important Announcements, and Picnic Invitation

Members,

Our rules have been updated and formally incorporated into our new Standard Operating Procedures. A direct link to these rules is available on our website for easy access. To maintain membership in the gun club, all members are required to review, understand, and agree to comply with these rules annually. We have made significant investments in range security, including keycard access and new camera systems, with additional cameras planned in the coming years. All reported or observed infractions will be investigated, and keycard access will be revoked for individuals found in violation. We cannot allow the actions of a few to jeopardize safety or damage club property. This includes ignoring safety rules, failing to clean up after use, or damaging props such as barrels and walls provided for law enforcement and member use.

This year's membership picnic is June 13th from 11:00 to 3:00. This year at the picnic you can pay with cash, check, or card (card price is \$155). If you know someone interested in joining, we will be doing range safety orientations hourly. You are also welcome to set up at the Cowboy tables if you would like to sell some items. If you cannot attend the picnic, please try to have your membership renewed by July 1st. After July 1st, we will be turning off the keycards of anyone who has not renewed. If the keycard is turned off, it can take up to two weeks to get it turned back on after your renewal is mailed.

This year's Youth Day is July 18th. That is the second Saturday of the Putnam County Fair. We plan to set up a tent at the fair and hand out flyers. We strongly encourage our members to bring their kids and grandkids, church groups, or civic organizations to this event. It is a fantastic opportunity to introduce youth to the shooting sports. Events typically include 3D archery, scholastic archery, air rifles, pellet guns, rimfire smallbore, rimfire lever actions, rimfire steel challenge, sling shot gallery, muzzle loaders, and skeet shooting. The event is free for kids and there will be concessions on site. We also need volunteers.
