2026 Introduction to Bullseye Pistol Matches

LOCATION: Putnam County Park, Eleanor, W.Va. Follow signs at Park to range.

GENERAL: These matches are designed for shooters of all experience levels who want to have fun, build confidence, improve marksmanship, and gain an introduction to **precision pistol (bullseye)** competition. You may use **any caliber pistol** you prefer (with **.22 LR or 9mm recommended**), any style of sights, and shoot from the standing position using **either one or two hands**.

All shooting is done on **NRA B-8 targets at 25 yards**. No specialized skills are required beyond the ability to safely handle your firearm.

Required Gear:

- Eye and ear protection
- Empty Chamber Indicator (ECIs will be provided if you don't have one)

Recommended Gear:

- Staple gun
- Masking tape for repairing targets
- Clipboard and pen/pencil for scoring

Match Structure

Each event includes a series of **slow fire**, **timed fire**, and **rapid fire** stages:

- **Slow Fire:** 10 shots in 10 minutes
- **Timed Fire:** Two 5-shot strings, 20 seconds each
- **Rapid Fire:** Two 5-shot strings, 10 seconds each

We will fire **two 90-shot matches** and **three 30-shot matches**. Shooters may participate in any or all events.

A **90-shot match** includes **three full cycles** of each stage, while a **30-shot match** includes **one full cycle**.

DATES & TIMES: Apr 19th, May 24th, Jun 21st, Jul 26th, Aug 16th, Sep 20th, and Oct 14th.

Registration at 9:00 a.m., firing begins promptly at 9:30 a.m. Bring your own lunch.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all shooters who do not have an NRA or CMP pistol classification. New shooters are encouraged to attend.

FEES FOR PCGC MEMBERS: \$10.00 for the first 90-shot match, \$5.00 for the second. \$2.00 for each 30shot match (or all three for \$5.00). Challenge Fee, \$1.00, and will be returned if challenge is upheld. (Nonmembers of the PCGC pay the same as above plus a \$5.00 range upkeep fee.)

AWARDS: Cash awards will be given depending on the number of participants: One award for up to 3 shooters, two for 4 to 7, three for 8 or more in class
