2025 Introduction to Bullseye Pistol Matches

LOCATION: Putnam County Park, Eleanor, W.Va. Follow signs at Park to range.

GENERAL: These matches are designed for any shooter who wants to have fun, improve shooting skills, and obtain an introduction to the precision pistol (bullseye) style of matches. You may shoot any caliber pistol you like (.22 or 9mm are highly recommended), any type of sights, standing position, either one- or two-handed. All targets are NRA B8 targets shot at a distance of 25 yards. No special skills are required, other than the ability to handle your pistol safely. Ear and eye protection are required. Empty Chamber Indicators must be used and will be provided if you don't have one. If possible you should bring a staple gun and masking tape for posting and repairing targets and a clipboard and pen or pencil for scoring targets.

We will be shooting two 90-shot matches and three 30-shot matches. You may participate in any or all as you see fit. The course of fire includes three stages: slow fire, timed fire, and rapid fire. Slow fire is one ten-shot string fired in 10 minutes. Timed fire is two five-shot strings, 20 seconds per string. Rapid fire is two five-shot strings, 10 seconds per string. A 90-shot match involves three examples of each stage, while a thirty-shot match has one of each.

DATES & TIMES: APRIL 13, MAY 4, JUNE 15, JULY 6, AUGUST 10, SEPTEMBER 7, and OCTOBER 12 (all Sundays). Registration at 9:00 a.m., firing begins promptly at 9:30 a.m. Bring your own lunch.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all shooters who do not have an NRA or CMP pistol classification. New shooters are encouraged to attend.

FEES FOR PCGC MEMBERS: \$10.00 for the first 90-shot match, \$5.00 for the second. \$2.00 for each 30-shot match (or all three for \$5.00). Challenge Fee, \$1.00, and will be returned if challenge is upheld. (Nonmembers of the PCGC pay the same as above plus a \$5.00 range upkeep fee.)

AWARDS: Cash awards will be given depending on the number of participants: One award for up to 3 shooters, two for 4 to 7, three for 8 or more in class
