Be sure to read, understand, and agree with the information below before signing your application (page 1). Putnam County Gun Club policy prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, sex, religion, or disability.

Information given on the Application/Renewal form can only be accessed by the Membership Chairman and the Officers. Your information will not be forwarded to any individuals, organizations, or companies. We request all members to check our website for the latest information including rule changes and range closures before going to the range. All PCGC documents and signs are subject to change as needed to provide a safe environment for our members and guests. In addition, your email address may be used to contact you on urgent matters or important web site updates.

Pledge of Agreement:

I certify that I am a citizen of good repute of the United States of America; that I am not a member of any organization or group having as its purpose, or one of its purposes, the overthrow by force and violence of the Government of the United States or any of its political subdivisions; that I have never been convicted of a crime of violence; that I and my family are legally allowed to own a firearm; and that, if approved as a member, I will fulfill the obligations of good citizenship and good sportsmanship.

Range and Safety Rules

*Always visit our website at putnamcountygunclub.com before visiting the range. We will make our best attempt to keep the site up to date with range activities and events. * When arriving at the range, be sure to check in at the Registration Hut. You are required to sign in and out of the range and identify the ranges used while visiting. Check bulletin board located in the Registration Hut for additional information. * The Park and the Gun Club are game sanctuaries. Cease fire until animals have left the range. * Obey the requests of club officers, safety awareness personnel and match directors.* Membership badges must be worn and visible at all times. * Guest(s) must remain with member at all times, and is responsible for the actions of their guests.* All guests must complete and sign a waiver form. Forms and instructions are located in the registration hut.* Mowing and construction activities are weather sensitive. Disruption to the range is typically less than two hours. Contractors have the right-of-way when performing work.* Report inappropriate behavior and rule violations to a club officer as soon as possible. Attempt to obtain as much information such as; name, vehicle, license plate, time of day, etc. * Absolutely no alcohol, illegal drugs or drugs that impair judgement. * The use of traces, incendiary materials, armor piercing rounds, shotgun slugs, buckshot, tannerite, non-lead bullets (on the cowboy range), and steel-core ammunition is prohibited without approval from the executive officer. * Do not move PCGC targets without approval from the executive officer.* Hearing and eye protection is mandatory for all shooters and spectators on or near the firing line. *The shooter is responsible for each round fired. Rounds must impact the backstop and all shots must be fired straight towards the target (90 degrees) to the firing line. * Each range will have a posted prohibited ammunitions and rules specific to that range. Always review and understand that ranges specific rules before using that range.* Unless otherwise posted the firing line is the downrange edge of the concrete pad, forward shelter support poles, anchored tables or designated by signs or range SOP. * All firearms must be unloaded, actions open, safety placed on a table (or cased) and remain out of arms reach when a cease fire is called and before anyone goes down range. All other shooters must acknowledge the cease fire before anyone goes down range. No firearms can be handled during a cease fire. * Penalties for breaking PCGC rules include warnings, fines, and suspension of membership privileges up to loss of membership.
