2021 Outdoor 1800 Aggregate Precision Pistol Matches NRA Approved

LOCATION: Putnam County Park, Eleanor, W.Va. Follow signs at Park to range.

GENERAL: All matches are 2-gun, 1800 Aggregate (.22 caliber and Centerfire), plus a Service Pistol (Hardball) Match, a Distinguished Revolver Match (open sights and .38 cal. only), and a .22 Rimfire EIC Match (open sights only). One relay, 15 shooters maximum; preference given to those shooting the entire match. NOTES: (1) The 1800 Aggregates are NRA-sanctioned Open Division matches. *The Service Pistol, Revolver, and .22 Rimfire Matches are for practice only; scores are not reported to NRA or CMP.* (2) Empty Chamber Indicators must be used and will be available. Ear and eye protection are required. (3) The range is equipped with stationary targets.

DATES & TIMES: APRIL 18, MAY 23, JUNE 20, JULY 25, AUGUST 15, SEPTEMBER 12, and OCTOBER 10 (all Sundays). Registration at 9:00 a.m., firing begins promptly at 9:30 a.m. Lunch break (bring your own) after the Centerfire match.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all shooters. Current NRA conventional pistol rules will apply. New shooters are encouraged to attend.

CLASSIFICATION: Current NRA pistol classification, including Temporary Classification, will be used. If there are fewer than 2 shooters in a class (except for Tyro), they will be combined with the next higher class. Shooters competing in their first organized pistol match will be placed in the Tyro class.

FEES FOR PCGC MEMBERS: \$20.00 for the full 2-gun 1800 Aggregate, or \$15.00 for one gun (includes fee to NRA). Hardball Match, \$2.00; Revolver Match, \$2.00; .22 Rimfire Match, \$2.00 (or all three for \$5.00). Challenge Fee, \$1.00, and will be returned if challenge is upheld. (Nonmembers of the PCGC pay the same as above plus a \$5.00 range upkeep fee.)

AWARDS: Cash awards will be given as follows: SUBAGGREGATES and GRAND AGGREGATE – Open Winner in each; Class Awards: one award for up to 3 shooters, two for 4 to 7, three for 8 or more in class. HARDBALL MATCH – No classifications used. One award for up to 3 shooters, two for 4 to 7, three for 8 or more. REVOLVER MATCH and .22 RIMFIRE MATCH – Same as Hardball.

MATCH SCHEDULE: .22 Caliber – 900 Aggregate: 20 shots Slow Fire, 30 shots National Match Course, 20 shots Timed Fire, 20 shots Rapid Fire. Centerfire – Same as .22 Match. Hardball – 30 shots National Match Course. Revolver and .22 Rimfire – Same as Hardball. Targets: Slow Fire, B-6, 50 yards; Timed and Rapid, B-8, 25 yards.
