

There executive meeting is the last Thursday of every month to plan our upcoming events schedule.

Following are the job descriptions for each position:

President – Plan and lead meetings with the help of the executive committee, plan fair and outside functions and activities, run executive meetings, suggest speakers for meetings, write presidents note to members for BUZZZZ newsletter.

<u>Vice President</u> – Assist president in planning of meetings, fair and outside functions, lead meetings and write notes when president is unable to, support, assist and vote on matters regarding LCBA.

#### **LCBA Judging Accreditation Program**

There is a real need for qualified honey judges in Ohio, especially the northern part of the state. LCBA will offer this course free of charge to any interested party willing to put in the time and effort. The course will take place at Life Church, 1033 Elm St., Grafton, Ohio 44044 on Saturday, January 10, 2026, with an alternative date of January 31, should weather become inclement and inhibit driving.

A \$25.00 refundable fee will be required upon signup, and returned to you after the completion of the class. The class will be limited to a maximum number of ten (10) participants.

During this class you will learn the necessary equipment and their uses; for example, refractometer, polariscope, and Pfund scale. Additionally, LCBA is going to a standardized score card, so we will discuss scoring honey (in various forms), pollen, wax (in various forms) soap, lip balm, and anything else you may find in a standard honey show. There will be follow-up information forthcoming - this is a first notice! If you are interested in being considered for this class
