1. Chief Gary Taylor came to talk to us about Central Dispatch. Fairfield pays \$17,784/year or \$9.27 per capita (1,917 est. 2016 census) which is .17 per week/person, and .02/day per person. They feel like it's worth it. Detailed information available at the Town Office.
2. Alisha presented the update to the Zoning Bylaw review, the proposed map and the reasons behind the changes. She encouraged SB members to attend the next review meeting on December 3rd.
3. Moe reports that the 2012 is in the shop. It's still under warranty. 550 is getting it's equipment for snow removal installed just in time! Most roads were graded and washouts handled. Guardrails are still supposed to be installed on Rugg Rd.
4. SB okayed the road crew taking the day after Thanksgiving off, weather permitting. There will be no extra pay to come in if it snows and no carryover of time.
5. Amanda reports that the NWRP Grants in Aid Project for Branon Rd culvert replacement needs to happen by June 30, 2019
6. HUB International said no change in insurance. \$47,000/year except for workers compensation may change it slightly. No other quote received.
7. Taxpayer request to repave Mill St. We will have a look at it.
8. Gavin made a motion to approve the minutes. Charlie seconded. All in favor.
9. Health Officer reported on a request to inspect the property at 2993 Chester Arthur. Some question as to whether or not it's a rental. SB said to stay out of it as it does not seem to be a rental property.
10. Gavin made a motion to approve the warrants and to adjourn. Charlie seconded. All in favor.
