1. Alex Airoidi, Probation and Parole. Here to offer work services, has contracts with other towns, parks & recreation department, fish and wildlife, Went over contract and payment terms per offender, per day. Gave some examples of work they have done. Amanda to follow up with Alex when work comes up.
2. Kelly Viens – St. Albans Rec Dept. City tax discount on program, scholarships etc. Possible discount for Fairfield residents. Last year Fairfield residents spent \$9,813 and if the discount was in effect Fairfield would have paid \$2,945. Programs include swim lessons, day camp and babysitting
3. Paving discussion. Two bids. Whitcomb \$134,791.80, unit price \$62.74. Pike price \$134,629.40, unit price \$61.70. Charlie made a motion to approve the Pike bid. They are also to pave the basketball court in Fairfield Center. To be completed before July 1. Tom second. All in favor.
4. Moe gave town road update. Still looking to replace the red 3500. Prices on a Ford 550
5. Sue Magnan gave a library update.
6. Fairfield Rec/ St. Albans rec. Motion to partake in St. Albans rec program at discounted price. Charlie moves to approve. All in favor. One-year trial.
7. Amanda brought the solar letter of support for Rainville to be signed.
8. Resolution that stemmed from town meeting on Rte. 36 to be repaired by State is being sent by Amanda to DOT, Governors office, Dan Connor, Town of Bakersfield, Town of Fletcher, NWRPC. Town of Bakersfield and Fletcher also had resolutions at their town meeting that will be sent as well.
9. Salt Shed- Amanda spoke to Scott Gurley at State regarding terminating the Salt Shed Grant and moving forward on construction as our own general contractor. An official letter will be written by Amanda. Do not have to pay back design and engineering.
10. Gavin made a motion to approve the minutes. Charlie seconded. All in favor.
11. Charlie made a motion to approve the warrants and adjourn. Norm seconded. All in favor.
