1. Moe reviewed what's happening with roads. Rugg Rd. culverts got in before the storm. Some truck issues with the 550, 2012 and 2015. Hope to have them back before the next storm. Updated on the warning light on Chester Arthur and North Road. Still not working properly. Some residents in East Fairfield requesting more sand
2. Library trustees came to present the library budget for 2019. Would rather have the full board to make a decision. Will decide by December 10th. Please attend then.
3. Charlie made a motion to approve the minutes. Norm seconded. All in favor.
4. \$300K tax anticipation loan has been paid off. Cost \$1,311 in interest.
5. Amanda reviewed the sidewalk meeting. Seems all are now in support with the exception of a change that brings it closer to Dukas' property. We save \$65K in drainage by moving it further from the road. December 8th site inspection with flags placed for all to review. We should be able to find a solution for less than \$65K
6. Shila Boomhower would like to renew the lease on the old town office building. We need to have a look at the posts in the front of the building and a little concrete work needs doing on the stairs. All ok.
7. No ordinance for speed limit posted on North Road. The speed ordinance shall now contain a speed of 25mph to Pat Branon at 224 North Rd and then change to 40mph until the town line. Signs to be placed after each intersection in both directions
8. Sand Shed construction total was \$389K. Paid by a \$200K loan, \$135,769 capital improvement fund and \$48,400 from the general fund. Closed with the State. They wanted feedback on whether it was worth not taking State Grant Funds. Absolutely! We saved lots of money doing it ourselves and we have a better building.
9. AM Peisch engagement letter signed for next year's audit.
10. Dec. 10th budget wrap up meeting at 6pm. December 13 – 10am budget meeting
11. Charlie made a motion to approve the warrants and to adjourn. Gene seconded. All in favor.
