Select Board Minutes
September 13, 2010**

Gavin opened the meeting at 7:30pm

1. Debra Hastings came to discuss the ditch work in front of her house. It has been reworked. A truck had to go over the septic tank ditch. The culvert on the left side facing the house didn't need a ditch. Some gravel was brought in but it wasn't done right. There wasn't a ditch there previously so Mrs. Hastings doesn't feel they should be responsible for purchasing a culvert. We can bring more stone to try to alleviate the issue. The Town isn't liable for any future septic issues. That would fall on the landowner.
2. Jason Booth came to discuss Cassidy's furniture store on the corner of Mill St. and Route 36. No parking exists and are times when cars block view of the intersection. This causes traffic issues.
3. Gene made a motion to approve the minutes. Norm seconded. All in favor.
4. No bill received from the Trudells.
5. Chris Reed got the sand bid after clarification of screening.
6. Ivan Charbonneau is going to have 1400 yards of black top that he is excavating and crushing. He is looking to get rid of it. Norm thought we may want to try some if the State would allow it to be used and if it isn't cost prohibitive.
7. We need to call Bill Hannon to request that he continue to work on Ancient Roads.
8. Truck is going to be ready shortly. Randy Clark asked if he could use the truck for the town fair Rider and Drive. He going ~~to better~~ the truck at his expense in exchange for the use of the truck.
9. Amanda spoke to VLCT about tax collection being rolled into office with out changing the Town Charter.
10. Amanda asked if anyone had spoken to Stephan Tetreault about researching the Town Common to locate the ~~dead~~ for the Common and to find points for the survey.
11. Library construction warrants will be coming in shortly. Amanda would like to have a board member assigned to over see and sign on behalf of the Board. Gavin made a motion that Gene be in charge of this on behalf of the SB. Norm seconded the motion. All in favor.
12. Norm said the excavator is going back. Paradee Road needs to be graveled and the ditches need to be groomed. Finish material needs to be put on top. Lafayette will put on guardrails later in the fall. Norm to talk to Franklin Rental about purchasing the pump that we have been renting. We can purchase for a little more than we paid to rent.
13. Mulcher is coming from Bechards tomorrow.

14. Gavin made a motion to approve the warrants and adjourn. Norm seconded. All in favor.
