

Restoring the Common School

A lesson in legacy – restoring Fairfield Center's historic schoolhouse

The Common School is a historic schoolhouse built in 1809 and an important landmark in Fairfield Center. The Town is supporting residents develop plans to bring it back to life as an asset central to our town's community.

The Town of Fairfield received a grant to develop architectural schematic designs and cost estimates to restore the Common School around a community vision. Based on initial community input and discussion, the Common School Working Group has prioritized the building for use by the Black Creek After School program run by the Fairfield Community Center, but the intention is to restore the building with some flexibility for a range of uses.





The Common School Working Group meets on the 4th Thursday of each month.
