



# **Young Actors Guild Health and Safety Guidelines**

During all in person activities with the Young Actors Guild, for health and safety reasons, all members, and attendees must agree to obey the following precautions. If by chance a member or attendee cannot obey the precautions, they will be asked to leave, as health and safety if everyone else at the event is the number one priority of the Young Actors Guild. These rules are in place as a response to COVID-19 and the CDC's recommendations regarding COVID-19.

In effect as of June 21<sup>st</sup> 2022

Precautions you must follow:

- Every member/attendee and volunteer must wear a mask at all times during the duration of the in person event.
- Masks are not mandatory for tech rehearsals or performances.
- At outdoor events, masks are not required for participants.
- Eating and drinking are the only times it's acceptable to remove your mask. When you remove your mask, you must be 6 feet away from other people.
- If food is brought to rehearsal, it must not be shared.
- Face shields are only allowed if a show director decides it is safe and necessary to use them.
- If you are not comfortable, you do not have to wear a face shield, you can keep your face mask on.

- Before an event starts, you must wash/sanitize your hands.
- Temperature checks will be administered to any member that is exhibiting symptoms of illness.
- If a temperature is above 99.9, the participant will be sent home.
- Any participants, including guests, of any event who have tested positive for COVID-19, or have been in physical contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19 within a 10 day period, prior to the event, will not be allowed to participate until 10 days has passed.
