It all begins with a hop on, of course, at any of the conveniently located stops. Board one of the orange and green trolleys and enjoy the view with a live commentary of interesting facts and stories from an expert guide who knows the island inside and out. Learn about the history and happenings of Key West—stories of pirates, Indians, wrecking and the Civil War—as the trolley rolls along from one location to the next. Hop off at any of the attractions for a closer look, then hop back on when it's convenient.

Visit popular sites like Mallory Square, where everyone comes to hang out, eat and shop. Be sure to make a stop at the popular Hog's Breath Saloon. There are the attractions near the historic seaport area, like West Martello Fort and Ripley's Believe it or Not. There's the Southernmost Point with the Key West Butterfly and Nature Conservatory. There's also the Ernest Hemingway House and Museum and Bahama Village Market plus Key West Aquarium and Key West Shipwreck Treasures Museum. It truly is a fun and fast way to get to know the island city of Key West and the many amazing attractions it offers.

Afternoon Snorkel and Sail Adventure

After boarding your sailing CAT in the nearby Historic Key West Seaport, you will head out across the warm, blue waters of the Florida Keys to North America's only living coral reef. During your sail to the reef, the staff will pass out the included snorkeling gear and give a safety and snorkeling orientation. The boat is equipped with a sun deck and shaded areas, as well as a restroom. Upon arrival, you will enter the water via the "stairway to the sea" and explore the coral reef, home to over 50 dazzling species of coral, and more than 150 varieties of vividly colored tropical fish and marine life. After snorkeling, rinse off in the freshwater shower before enjoying an ice-cold beer, wine or soda, as your CAT glides across the beautiful blue sea. This tour also includes an open liquor bar.

Explore Old Town by Bike

Embark on a captivating bicycle tour through the heart of Old Town Key West, guiding you from the southernmost tip to the northern edges of the island. This two-wheeled adventure concludes with a delightful taste of the famous Key Lime Pie.

Ideal for first-time visitors eager to see Key West through the eyes of a local, and perfect for those with limited time but a desire to experience the city's lively spirit. Begin your journey with a brief on safety before hopping on your bike. You'll glide through the town's most cherished landmarks, including Mallory Square, The Mel Fisher Museum, and The Little White House. Enjoy up to 10 to 15-minute stops at each site to soak in the history, sights, and sounds. Your itinerary also features the iconic Hemingway House, the bustling Southernmost Point, and the vibrant Duval Street, among other must-see spots.

Key West: Museum Culture Pass For 4 Great Museums - \$45 (TAAPS)

Get ready to visit The Key West Art and History Museum at the historic Customs House, The Tennessee Williams Museum, The Key West Lighthouse, and Fort East Martello, featuring the infamous Robert the Doll. The spirit of Key West's past awaits, all with the swipe of your Culture Pass at your pace.

Shipwreck Treasure Museum Tickets - \$19 (TAAPS)

Key West and the Florida reef system are home to all kinds of historical treasures. Visit the Shipwreck Treasure Museum to learn about pirates and treasure while experiencing a view of the ocean from atop a tall observation tower 90 feet (30 m) in the air. Years ago, the dangerous waters surrounding Key West played host to more than 100 ships per day. These ships would frequently fail at navigating the local reefs and sandbars, where they would often wreck and sink. Visit the museum to see actual artifacts from a wrecked vessel, the *Isaac Allerton*, which sank in 1856. Leave modern America for a moment and venture back in time with the museum's actors. Learn about the early Key West pioneers and discover amazing facts about the wrecking industry, maritime heritage, and the history of iconic Key West.
