Le Verdon-sur-Mer is an industrial port used as a gateway to the Bordeaux region of France. Bordeaux is a two hour drive away. At first glance, it appears the ship has docked in a cow pasture! The town is a little over a mile walk, a bedroom community, there isn't much to see but a wide beach to explore. Often, cruise lines organize a shuttle bus to Soulac-sur-Mer, which is a bit more populated and has some shopping opportunities.
