

Costa Maya, Mexico

Costa Maya is a port built in the small fishing community of Mahahual. The ITM group developed this large pier and port exclusively to attract cruise guests. It is the closest port of access to many of the lesser-known Mayan ruins in the Yucatan including Chacchoben and Kohunlich as well as Bacalar Lagoon.



Royal Caribbean purchased this port in September 2024. They have plans to open "Perfect Day Mexico" in 2027 exclusively to their guests. The majority of the port will remain open to other cruise lines.



Food

The port is home to several restaurants and cafes serving traditional fare and of course, margaritas.

Culture

Mayan ruins of Chacchoben and Kohunlich are within an hour, tours are offered. The port offers several shows daily of Mayan ceremonies.



Animals

The port is home to flamingos, dolphins, and parrots. Monkeys are often seen When visiting Chacchoben.



Language

Spanish is the official language of Mexico. English is spoken exclusively in the port area.

Currency

Is the Peso. 1 US Dollar = \$20.39 in Pesos. Vendors near the port will take US dollars and handle the conversion math. Major credit cards accepted in many locations.

Cell Service

Very scant cell service.

Available at most cafes and pubs with your purchase.

Drive

On the right hand side of the road. There are few if any rentals available.
