symptoms	test should be followed if an individual has one

	taste/smell.) Those that are not vaccinated
	should do so if someone in their household has
	symptoms also.
Transfer of virus from touching surfaces	Hand sanitiser to be used when entering the
	church. Surfaces regularly cleaned.
Transfer of virus in the air	When the church is busier, and people cannot
	space out, open windows, and/or doors. Flush
	the main building with fresh air between
	services. Masks are available for those who
	would like them, and can be worn throughout
	the service, or just when coming/going.
Preacher/ worship leader facing congregation	Those participating in a role facing the
	congregation are encouraged to take a LFT
