## JESUS HAS THE AUTHORITY TO HEAL MATTHEW 8:1-17

MATTHEW 7:28-29 28 And when Jesus finished these sayings, the crowds were astonished at his teaching, 29 for he was teaching them as one who had authority, and not as their scribes.

Jesus Christ shows he is Messiah by healing the outcast, the enemy and the insignificant.

### JESUS HEALS A LEPER [OUTCAST] (v.1-4)

- Jesus healing a leper shows us both His AUTHORITY and His COMPASSION because this healing doesn't just bring physical restoration, but SOCIAL restoration as well.
- Jesus RESTORES every part of this man's BROKENNESS.

### JESUS HEALS A CENTURIAN'S SERVANT [THE ENEMY] (v.5-13)

- Notice the Centurion's HUMILITY and FAITH as he comes to Jesus and asks for help for his servant.
- Notice Jesus' KINDNESS and ENCOURAGEMENT toward the Centurion.
- Jesus MARVELS at this man's faith while warning of the FAITHLESSNESS of the Jews.
- The GREATNESS of our faith doesn't lie in the STRENGTH of our faith but the OBJECT of our faith... Jesus!
- It is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone that Jesus is GATHERING THE NATIONS to Himself!

### JESUS HEALS PETER'S MOTHER-IN-LAW [INSIGNIFICANT] & OTHERS (v.14-17)

- Jesus has ALL AUTHORITY to heal.
- When Jesus heals both PHYSICALLY and SPIRITUALLY it is COMPLETE, IMMEDIATE and ETERNAL.

Hebrews 7:23–25 (ESV)

- The greatest miracle Jesus ever performs is the miracle of the FORGIVENESS OF SINS.
- Jesus' PHYSICAL HEALING points to a greater reality, SPIRITUAL HEALING.
