Peace! What peace?

Luke 2:1-14, Colossians 1:19-22

If Jesus is the *Prince of Peace*, why is there so little peace?

1. Chaos began when our great grandparents rebelled against God. Genesis 2:15-17, 3:1-22, 4:3-13. Anger & Strife come from our sin nature always wanting more. Romans 5:12
2. Jesus, the Prince of Peace, brought peace and reconciliation to those who believe the Gospel. Colossians 1:21-22, Romans 5:1,

We live in the *Already, Not Yet Kingdom*. Already - Jesus offers deep, supernatural peace to those who follow Him. We are waiting for Jesus to bring complete peace.
