Dishonor God, killed authentic worship for one year; physical distress and weakness, victimized Bathsheba through power rape and loss of her husband, murdered Uriah Bathsheba's husband and other soldiers, ordered General Joab to murder men, hurt loyalty in the army, Ahithophel the grand father of Bathsheba held bitterness for 12 years he caused rebellion. David's sons and grandsons followed in David's footsteps of sin. God specifically disciplined David in three ways: 1. Killed David's infant son 2. Never had peace in his home 3. David would be publicly shamed.
