V. Christ Creates One New People (Ephesians 2:15)

“That he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace.”

Christian reconciliation is not merely ending conflict. It is becoming family.

VI. The Cross Gives Us Power to Forgive (Ephesians 2:16-17)

The reason we forgive is because we ourselves were forgiven.

VII. Through Christ We Both Have Access to the Father  
(Ephesians 2:18)

“For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father.”

Final Application

Ask yourself:

- Is there a wall I have built?
- Is there bitterness I am protecting?
- Is there someone I need to forgive?
- Is there someone I need to seek out?
- Is there sin I need to confess?

Some people want revival while refusing reconciliation.

But revival often begins with humility, confession, and a difficult conversation.

### One in Christ: Reconciled Through the Cross

- I. Sin Creates Separation and Hostility (Ephesians 2:11-12)  
"Remember that at one time you Gentiles... were separated from Christ... having no hope and without God in the world."
  
- II. Jesus Brings Near Those Who Were Far Away (Ephesians 2:13)  
"But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ."
  
- III. Jesus Destroys the Walls Between People (Ephesians 2:14)  
"For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility."
