1. A Healthy Church Is a Learning Church

- A. Biblical preaching produces God honoring churches.
 - B. Healthy preaching begins with objective truth.
 - C. We can trust the Bible.
 - D. Expository preaching allows Scripture to set the agenda.
- Core Value Bible Equipped: We will grow in Christ through teaching, study and constant practice of God's reliable Word. (2 Timothy 3:16-17, 1 Timothy 4:13-16, Ezra 7:10, Hebrews 5:14)
