SERMON NOTES

Embracing Radical Love

Because Jesus radically loved us,
we radically love one another.

1. The COMMAND - Love one another as Jesus loved us.
John 13:1-17, 34-35
 2. The CHARACTER - As Christ transforms us, His patient, kind, humble, selfless, forgiving, enduring love increasingly becomes our character. 1 Corinthians 13:4-7
- What does love look like? Look at Jesus.
- Love is patient — Jesus was patient.
 - Love is kind — Jesus was kind.
 - Love does not insist on its own way — Jesus surrendered His rights.
 - Love keeps no record of wrongs — Jesus forgave.
 - Love bears all things — Jesus bore our sin.
 - Love endures all things — Jesus loved us all the way to the cross.
 - **Love is a settled disposition toward another person's good**
