"Hearing and Beholding the Parables of Kingdom Growth" Mark 4:26-34 (ESV)

26 And he said, "The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground. 27 He sleeps and rises night and day, and the seed sprouts and grows; he knows not how. 28 The earth produces by itself, first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in the ear. 29 But when the grain is ripe, at once he puts in the sickle, because the harvest has come."

30 And he said, "With what can we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable shall we use for it? 31 It is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when sown on the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on earth, 32 yet when it is sown it grows up and becomes larger than all the garden plants and puts out large branches, so that the birds of the air can make nests in its shade."

33 With many such parables he spoke the word to them, as they were able to hear it. 34 He did not speak to them without a parable, but privately to his own disciples he explained everything.✠

The Lord's Supper is a practice that is central to congregational worship in the Christian church. Today unleavened bread and grape juice will be distributed to you in prepackaged servings. We want you to know the meaning of eating unleavened bread and drinking grape juice together at church today. Taking the Lord's supper is a way for us to remember Jesus's death and to look forward to His return. This practice was begun by Jesus at an intimate Jewish Passover meal with His disciples. This annual gathering in commemoration of the Exodus from bondage in Egypt happened just before Jesus died to pay for the sins of the world. Jesus taught that the matzah symbolized His body and that the cup of wine taken after the meal symbolized His blood. One of Paul's letters declares *"For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes"* (1 Corinthians 11:26).



The Lord's Supper affirms our unity as believers in Jesus, we examine our hearts for any un-confessed sin and the Spirit of God assures our forgiven state as God's forever children. Participating in the Lord's Supper helps us to look forward to the time when Jesus will come again. So if you have accepted the gift of eternal life that Jesus has promised to all who believe in Him, then He has indeed forgiven your sins and you have a risen Savior! By all means then please join in and eat the bread and drink the grape juice which is symbolic of His broken body and His blood. But if you don't believe in Jesus yet, then taking these elements would be an outward ritual. Choosing to not participate makes more sense. Please don't be embarrassed, we have all been there. 😊
