



The first transcontinental telegraph system was completed on October 24, 1861 just a few months after the onset of the Civil War. Stephen J. Field, Chief Justice of California, sent a message to Abraham Lincoln assuring him of California's loyalty to the Union and promising that the telegraph line would "be the means of strengthening the attachment which binds both the East and the West to the Union." This was the first cross-country message on the new line on October 25, 1861.

In that moment California was brought within the circle of the sisterhood of States. No longer as one beyond the pale of civilization, but, with renewed assurances of peace and prosperity, she was linked in electrical bonds to the great national family union.
